Overture & Titles

Village Set / Cantonment / Rajah's Fort / Countryside / Table Top Int - Ext / Day - Night

A song is heard on the audio track which slowly becomes the background as a voice over begins.

सत १८९३.

चंपातेर... देश के बीचों बीच बसा, एक छोटासा गाँव.

चंपातेर के लोग, देश के हजारों गावों की तरह अपता गुजर-बसर, खेती-बाडी से करते थे.

गाँव की सीमा से लगकर, अंग्रेज हुकुमत की छावती थी.

और दक्षिण की ओर,छावती से दो कोस दूर, इस प्रान्त के राजा का किला था.

अंग्रेज, राजा के प्रान्त की, पड़ोसी राजाओं के आक्रमण से हिफाजत करते थे. और उन राजाओं को भी, वो इस राजा के आक्रमण से बचाने का वादा करते. इस दुगने खेल की बदौलत, अंग्रेज, उन राजाओं के साथ साथ, चंपानेर के राजा से भी लगान वसूल करते थे.

CUT TO... (3:00)

Scene 2

Yashodamai Intro - No rain!

Village: Bhuvan's House

Ext / Day

A deep blue sky - cloudless. A harsh afternoon sun.

A village woman, about 55, stands on a parched landscape looking skywards, her hand shading her eyes. Nearby, a small house under the scant shade of a withering neem tree. Sweat trickles down her forehead as she scans the horizon.

A villager, about 45, approaches the house with a bale of hay. He chucks it in a shed near the house and turns to her. He follows her gaze.

MAN

आज फिर टकटकी बांधे का देख रही है, माई?

Yashodamai completes her horizon-scan, sighs and turns to him.

YASHODAMAI

यहीं कि कब पड़ेंगे अकास पे बादलों के धब्बे. आंखें तरस गई! बरखा एक मास निकल गई... एक बूँद न पडीं धरती पे!

Yashodamai's attention is diverted by the sounds of restless cattle from the shed. She moves towards the shed talking to them. She gives them some hay, pours water in the gutter.

YASHODAMAI

वो तो किरपा है सिद्धेश्वर की... गाँव में पीने का पानी है - नई तो कलेजा सूख जाता. सब उसकी माया!

HARI

हाँ माई... पर खेत तो प्यासे हैं. दाना कैसे फूटेगा?

YASHODAMAI

धीरज रखो हरीभाई, अकास से ना मिला तो धरती का मन टटोलेंगे. माटी फाडके पानी निकालेंगें. यहीं मैंने भुवन से कहीं!

HARI

कहाँ है वो?

YASHODAMAI

सुबे से कहीं गया है. खाने का बखत हो गया है, दिखाई देवे तो भेज देना.

Suddenly a scream is heard. Both look in the direction of a neighbouring house.

VOICE

हरामियों... एक बार हत्थे लग जाओ... तुमरी भी चोंचें तोड दूँ. मरे मुच्चट्टे मुर्गियों का नकदम कर रे हैं.

Yashodamai nods her head as Hari smiles.

YASHODAMAI

ले भई! मुर्गी महाभारत फिर सुरु!

CUT TO ... (1:15)

Scene 3

Bhura - Goli Intro and British Troops

Village: Bhura-Goli's House

Int-Ext / Day

Bhura about 45 years old, chases a hen, catches it and places it under a basket. He sits down heaving, panting, tired; still murmuring curses. Just then, a stone hits the roof of the barn with a thud scaring the hens. But this time instead of collecting the hens he rushes out of the barn towards his fence.

In the distance, three children hide behind a man, about 30, who swings a gofan over his head with great speed to release yet another stone. Bhura ducks as it hits the roof of the barn. Bhura is infuriated.

BHURA

ऐ, गोली के बचे... ठूँस न दिया तोप की नली में तो भूरा नाम नई. तू है किस खेत का बछुआ कनचुड़े?

Goli rushes towards him, tentatively followed by the children. He reaches his side of the fence.

GOLL

तूने मेरे बालकन को काहे मारा?

BHURA

मारा? अरे पेड से उलटा लटाए के नीचे धुंआ सुलगा दूँगा. मेरी मुर्गियों को हैरान करें हैं मरे! तूने जादा टपर टपर करी तो तेरा ये गोफन भी फूंक दूँगा - भक से!

GOLI

अच्छा?

Goli starts to swing his gofan again, when Hari intervenes.

HARI

अब बसे भी करो. हर बखत की खिचखिच. कुत्ते के पिल्ले को भी मात कर दिए.

BHURA

और हरीकाका, इसके छोरे मेरी मुर्गियाँ छेडते हैं सो?

GOLI

मेरे बालकन पे हाथ उठाता है! अबे मुर्गियाँ हैं कि लौंडियाँ? छेड दिया तो इज्जत लुट गई का? ब्याह नहीं होगा तेरी मुर्गियों का!

HARI

अब बस भी करो. बचें ही तो हैं भूरा... और गोली! अपने बचों को समझा दे... ठीक है? अब बताओ... भुवन कहीं पे दिखा?

Bhura and Goli look at Hari quizzically.

GOLI

नहीं! तूने देखा भूरा?

BHURA

नहीं. काहे?

Just then, they are distracted by the roaring sounds of marching footsteps and horses. The children rush off excitedly towards the gate.

Hari, Bhura and Goli turn to see a platoon of native soldiers marching under command of a British NCO on horseback. The Union Jack flutters from the horseback.

The children shout commands in broken English at the troops.

CHILDREN

पलटून... फावड माच! लिपिट रैट... लिपिट रैट...

One of the British officers glares at the children as the soldiers' boots make powerful thumping sounds, rending the air with clouds of dust all along the main street of the village...

A legend appears on the screen - चंपातेर १८९३

CUT TO... (1:15)

Champaner is a small farming village in central India. As troops pass through the village it is evident that the presence of the British is not new. Arjan - the blacksmith stops for a moment to look at the troops, but continues to strike the hammer on his anvil adding his own rhythm to the march. Ismail - the potter also continues to shape his clay after a momentary pause. And so do the rest of the villagers. Ishwar - the vaid and baniya, the Mukhiya, Shambhukaka - the oldest man in the village and Kazi, all return to their routines. A bearded man, about 40, with long unkempt hair, looks intently at the last rank of the troops, spits and mutters to himself.

BEARDED MAN

हरामी कहीं के! धूप में जुगनू ढूँढ रहे हैं. गीदड की औलादों, एक दिन उसी गोरे टापू पर लौढ जाओगे, जहाँ से आए हो... भाग का सनिचर कोढ कोढ फलेगा... देक लेना!

He is brought out of his reverie by a girl's voice.

VOICE

ए गुरन, उनकी सनिचर कुंडली काहे बाँच रहा है? बहरे कानों पर झांझ बजाने से फैदा? मेरा नसीब बांच न!

Guran, the bearded man, turns to look at a pair of palms spread open before him. Then he looks at the girl. She is 19, beautiful with expressive eyes. Her eyes gleam as she faces Guran. Another girl, about the same age sits next to her listening intently.

GIRL

बोल ना! मुझे मेरे मन का राजकुमार मिलेगा?

GURAN

काहे नहीं! मन में इत्ता तप है तो तू उसी के कंगना पहनेगी... उसी की बिछिया!

GIRL

हाय सची? सुना जिगनी?

Both the girls are thrilled.

JIGNI

हाँ!

GIRL

जिगनी... आज मैं उसे बता के रहूँगी... उससे जबाब लेकर रहूँगी!

JIGNI

का कह रही है? तोको सरम-वरम है की नही.

The girl sheepishly nods. Guran stares intensely at her palms.

GURAN

(stares intensely at her palms) मगर.!

GIRL

मगर... का?

GURAN

मुझे एक अडचन नजर आ रही है...

GIRL

कैसी अडचन गुरन? जल्दी बता...

Just then, Hari reaches the village square and calls the girl.

HARI

गौरी..!

Gauri is embarrased as she quickly withdraws her hands whispering 'बाद में' to Guran and runs up to Hari. Jigni replaces Gauri and says 'ए गुरन मेरा नसीब बता'.

GAURI

का हरीकाका !

Hari leads her away from Guran.

HARI

गुरन तेरा भविस बांच रहा था?

GAURI

नहीं... हाँ...

HARI

पगला है. हाथ भर आगे की जिन्नगी कि समज है नहीं उसे. अनाप सनाप बकराता फिरे है.

GAURI

सो तो मती कहो हरीकाका, पगला नहीं है वो. दुर्गाभाभी की मालूम है? ब्याह के नौ साल तक उनकी कोख से कोंपल न फूटी. फिर गुरन बोला की लल्ला होगा. टिपू हुआ कि नहीं? और वो केसरिया का किस्सा ले लो...

HARI

ठीक है... ठीक है... वो पगला नहीं, बडा गुनी है... बस? अब बता, भुवन दिखा कहीं?

GAURI

दिखा तो नहीं, पर जानू हूँ कहाँ पे होगा.

A passer-by, about 25, overhears this and drops a bundle of firewood, his eyes on Gauri.

PASSER-BY

गजब है, पूरी खबर रखती है जन्नो!-

GAURI

ए लाखा... तोसे मतलब?

LAKHA

ले भई, सारा मतलब हमीं से और हमीं मूं न खोलें? पहन ले अब चूडी हमरे नाम की!

HARI

बेटा, का बक रहा है तू?

LAKHA

इमान की कह रहा हूँ बापू. तुम तो बुढा गए. यह जन्नो मेरी कोई खबर नहीं रखती... जे देखो... मरा जखम हुआ पडा है.

Lakha shows his cut palm to Hari and Gauri. She looks at it with concern and realises it is not major. She tries to break Lakha's sympathetic approach.

GAURI

जखम? तुझे मेरी नहीं, बापू की जरूरत है (turns and calls out) बापू...

A man under the shade of his roof looks in her direction while checking the pulse of another man who is seated. It is evident that they are in a dispensary.

GAURI

...लाखा के हाथ में फांस लग गई है...

MAN

ये लाखा का... का करूँ? ये लकडी कम और हाथ जादा कटवावे है.

LAKHA

का करूं इसरचाचा... (looks at Gauri) कट ही जावे है! कच से...

Lakha stares at her. She realises his implication and decides to ignore him.

GAURI

काका... मैं भुवन को लाती हूँ.

Gauri runs off. Lakha watches her leave and wipes the sweat off his face. Hari shouts after Gauri.

HARI

सुन तो... कहियो माई घर पे बाट जोह रही है.

CUT TO... (2:00)

A man intently watches through the dry shrub. In the distance, a deer pecks at some yellowing grass. The man, about 25, earrings in both ears, tanned body, watches the deer while he gropes for a stone and takes aim. Then he appears to listen for something. There is a distant click. He silently counts one-two-three and throws the stone at the deer which makes the deer duck in reflex.

Bang! A sound of gunfire is heard. The deer sprints off. A bullet mark appears on the bark of the tree before which the deer grazed a moment ago. After the echoes of the gunfire die down, an English voice roars in disappointment.

VOICE

Bloody hell, missed it again!

The young man looks in the direction of the voice. It is a British officer about 35 years old. He rushes forward with his hunting party.

BRITISH OFFICER

We must get it before it disappears! Ramsingh.

RAMSINGH

जी हुजूर!

BRITISH OFFICER

उधर से. Edward, you go around. Lets corner the blasted animal!

The young man in the shrub has a smile on his face as he watches the hunting party move. He turns and picks up a couple of bunches of tube-roots and swings them onto his shoulder. He too moves in the direction of the deer constantly using the foliage to camouflage him.

Cut to ...

5A

The chase is on between the hunting party and the young man, one trying to hunt the deer and the other trying to thwart the hunt.

Cut to ...

5B

The deer comes to a halt, unaware of the proximity of its hunters. The Officer takes aim once again, the young man also positions himself, places the tube-roots behind him and picks up a stone. The gun clicks again. The silent count is repeated. But as he is about to throw the stone, he freezes, as he feels the nozzle of a gun on his neck. He realises that it is a British soldier.

The British officer fires again. The deer flies off the ground in a fountain of blood, lands with a thud and dies screaming.

The young man is stunned as the stone falls from his hand. He is brought out of his hiding place.

SOLDIER

Sir, this darkie was hiding in the bushes. He had this in his hand.

The soldier holds the stone in his hand. The British Officer's eyes meet the young man's, who is now being held by two soldiers.

SOLDIER

He had been distracting the deer all this time.

BRITISH OFFICER

• समझा! पाँच बार मैं इस हिरन को क्यों नहीं मार सका! तुम... जानवरों के रक्षक हो?

RAMSINGH

किसान है हुजूर... अपने गाँव का!

BRITISH OFFICER

(smiles) You must be a very good runner...

The Officer aims his rifle at the young man. The two soldiers leave him and walk out of range. The young man is a little tense but does not flinch. Suddenly, the Officer aims the gun away behind the young man.

BRITISH OFFICER

Try saving this one!

He fires. A rabbit lies dead. The young man is furious, but helpless, his eyes moist.

BRITISH OFFICER

Next time I will shoot you. अगली बार निशाना तुम्हें बनाऊँगा.

Just then, three riders arrive. One of them dismounts and salutes the Officer.

RIDER

कॅप्टन रसल, हुजूर, राजा पुरण सिंगजी झाला कंटोनमेंट में आपका इंतजार कर रहें है.

RUSSELL

Puran Singh... what could he want now ..?

Russell's eyes do not leave the young man's as he mounts his horse and rides off with the other two riders. The young man watches him leave, heart pounding. The rest of the hunting party move towards the kill. The young man walks towards his hiding spot and picks up the tube-roots. Ramsingh is exasperated with the young man.

RAMSINGH

गोरे साहब से उलझने की तुम्हे क्या जरूरत थी, भुवन? वो तो अच्छा हुआ कि उनको जरूरी काम से जाना पड़ा, वरना वो क्या कब कर बैठें, कोई भरोसा नहीं...

Bhuvan glances at Ramsingh. Just then, a female voice is heard in the distance

VOICE

भू...वन! भू...वन!

Bhuvan, curious, walks out of the jungle into the clearing.

CUT TO... (3:45)

Lovers' Hill Ext / Day

Bhuvan reaches a picturesque hillock, on top of which stands Gauri calling out his name.

BHUVAN

गला फाड-फाडके काहे चिल्ला रही है?

GAURI

मैं तोको ढूँढ रही थी... नहीं दिखे तो...

BHUVAN

में कहाँ मर गया था?

GAURI

मैं का जानू कहाँ मर... हाय राम - का असगुन बोल रही थी मैं... इत्ते नाराज काहे हो रहा है?

Bhuvan is about to explain, but realises the futility and sighs.

BHUVAN

खैर! मतबल पे आ. का बात है?

GAURI

एक खास बात कहनी थी!

BHUVAN

का ?

GAURI

बैठ तो सही.

She makes him sit alongside.

BHUVAN

बोल!..

GAURI

गुरन ने मोको मेरा नसीब बताया है.

BHUVAN

अच्छा! कब फूट रहा है?

GAURI

धत! मैं नाही बताती!

BHUVAN

अच्छा... ठीक है... बता... अरे! बता ना...

GAURI

गुरनने कही की इसी साल... मेरी हल्दी हो जाएगी!.. मने ब्या!

Gauri looks meaningfully at Bhuvan. Though shocked at first, he decides to have fun.

BHUVAN

Gauri is speechless, but regains her composure.

GAURI

मुझे का पता... गुरनने ये नहीं बताया.

Gauri is depressed. Bhuvan slyly watches her. Gauri suddenly gets an idea.

GAURI

पर गुरनने इत्ती जरूर कही कि जिस घर मैं जाऊँगी, उस के आँगन में एक नीम का पेड होगा...

Bhuvan pretends to be trying to figure out which house in the village has a neem tree in the yard..

Gauri eyes him and goes a step further.

GAURI

घर के बगल में एक बड़ा खेत होगा...

Bhuvan pretends to go in a trance trying to figure it out.

GAURI

दो भैंसें होंगी... एक जोडी बैल... तीन बकरीयाँ...

Bhuvan likes her innocence as she goes in a trance.

GAURI

गुरन ने कही कि मेरा घर एक छोटासा सुरग होगा...

She dreamily sighs and looks at him. Bhuvan maintains an amazed expression.

BHUVAN

वाह! का बात है ? और का चाहिए तुझे ? तू है नसीबवाली...

GAURI

नसीबवाली? कैसी नसीबवाली?

BHUVAN

भई घर सुरग. और का चाहती है?

GAURI

राम जाने का होगा मेरा! अच्छा भुवन... एक बात बोल, तोको कैसी लडकी पसंद है?

He looks at her thoughtfully.

BHUVAN

मुझे..? मुझे तो वोई छोरी पसंद आवेगी जो मेरी माँ को पसंद आवेगी.

GAURI

(forces a smile) माँ को पसंद आवेगी!

Suddenly, Gauri remembers Hari's message.

GAURI

हे भगवान!

BHUVAN

का हुआ?

Gauri looks at him from the corner of her eyes trying to gauge his mood.

GAURI

दरअसल... मैं तोको ये बताने आई थी कि माँ ने तोको बुलाया है.

BHUVAN

और बता अब रही है? इत्ते बखत के बाद? अब तू बैठी रह. मैं चला!

GAURI

ए भु... वन ! मुझे माफ कर दे... सुन तो!

BHUVAN

चुप!

Down the hillock, Bhuvan hears a faint bugle. He turns and sees a Union Jack fluttering proudly in the distance atop a palace dome. The sounds of bugles increase. Bhuvan's face hardens.

CUT TO... (2:00)

Scene 7

Puran Singh & Elizabeth Intro - Eat the Meat!

Cantonment: Garden

Ext / Day

Three horsemen enter a Summer Palace premises which has now been transformed into a British cantonment. Captain Russell is received by a soldier who helps him dismount and takes away the horse. The cantonment is a shocking green amidst the aridity of the barren landscape. A 'bhishti' i.e. a water-bearer waters the plants.

Russell looks in the direction of a man, about 50 years old, bejewelled and ornately dressed. Russell does a quick bow. This is Puran Singh.

RUSSELL

Rajahji!

As he walks, a couple of soldiers give him a change of attire - riding boots are replaced and the hunting hat is taken away.

PURAN SINGH

आपका शिकार कैसा रहा ?

RUSSELL

Your Highness! अंग्रेज शिकार के खेल में दुनिया में सबसे आगे हैं. The British Empire is the best in the world.

PURAN SINGH

बिल्कुल, लेकिन हमें फिक्र है...

RUSSELL

क्या ?

PURAN SINGH

जब जंगल में शिकार ही नहीं बचेगा... तब कौनसा खेल खेलेगी बंदूक? हा... हा... हा...

Russell joins in Puran's laughter.

RUSSELL

हमारी खुशकिरमती आप यहाँ पधारे हैं, लेकिन हम वजह नहीं जानते.

PURAN SINGH

हम आपके पास, अपनी प्रजा की तरफ से एक दरख्वास्त लेकर आयें हैं.

RUSSELL

दरख्वास्त ?

A beautiful English girl, about 22, joins them.

RUSSELL

Good morning Eliza... Your Highness! पेश करता हूँ, मेरी प्यारी बहन, Elizabeth. कल रात को ही आई है लंदन से. Elizabeth, His Highness Rajah Puran Singh Jhala of Champaner. Elizabeth gives a little bow. Puran Singh takes her hand and kisses it formally.

PURAN SINGH

अलभ्य लाभ!.. हम खुश हुए...

RUSSELL

राजाजी इसे हिन्दी नहीं आती...

PURAN SINGH

Oh... of course! Charmed to meet you, Miss Russell.

ELIZABETH

Pleased to meet you, Your Highness!

PURAN SINGH

It is a privilege to have you in India. Miss Russell. कॅप्टन साब, इन्हें हम दावत देना चाहते है...

RUSSELL

जरूर... यहाँ छुट्टी पर आई है... और मुझे उम्मीद है कि उसे यहाँ ब्रिटिश हिंदुस्थान में, एक अच्छा सा... क्या कहते है... जीवन साथी मिल जाएगा.

PURAN

ओहो... शुभ शुभ... ये गुलाबी हाथ हिंदुस्थान में पीले होंगे? देवी कृपा! There are plenty good officers here.

Elizabeth realises what Russell has mentioned to Puran Singh.

ELIZABETH

No, no! Rubbish, Andrew! That's the last thing on my mind.

The three move towards an ornately laid out tea-table in the well-manicured lawn, surrounded by flowering plants. A British Officer, about 25, hits his heels in attention and salutes Russell.

RUSSELL

At ease, Smith.

Smith bows to Puran Singh saying 'Rajahji'.

RUSSELL

Elizabeth, meet my deputy, Captain Patrick Smith...

Russell whispers to Elizabeth.

RUSSELL

Eligible bachelor!

Elizabeth ignores the remark and gracefully offers her hand to greet a nervous Smith.

ELIZABETH

How do you do, Captain Smith!

SMITH

Fine! Pleased to meet your grace.

It is evident that Smith is smitten by Elizabeth's beauty. They sit. Russell and Puran Singh face each other. So do Elizabeth and Smith.

RUSSELL

तो राजाजी... हुकुम?

Two uniformed bearers come and place snacks on the table- assorted sandwiches. Elizabeth serves.

PURAN SINGH

कॅप्टन साहब, तीन साल हो गए, हमारी प्रजा ने सिद्धेश्वर के मंदिर में पूजा नहीं की है. उनको विश्वास है कि पिछले साल से उनपर जो तकलीफें आई, वो सब उस मंदिर में पूजा करने से खत्म हो जाएँगी. लेकिन...

RUSSELL

लेकिन जिस प्रांत में मंदिर है, उस प्रांत का राजा है राजा दिलेर सिंग, आपका चर्चरा भाई और दुश्मन...

PURAN SINGH

और आपका अजीज दोस्त, कॅप्टन रसल. अगर आप दिलेर सिंग से बात करें, तो वो आपकी बात नहीं टालेगा.

Elizabeth offers Puran Singh a plate of sandwiches.

PURAN SINGH

जी नहीं, शुक्रिया मिस रसल, हम शाकाहारी हैं. I'm a vegetarian.

Puran notices Russell lost in thought.

PURAN SINGH

तो क्या सोच रहे हैं रसल साहब ? क्या ये मुमकिन है ?

RUSSELL

Well, he could be persuaded... आपका काम हो सकता है... But, on one condition. एक शर्त है...

PURAN SINGH

शर्त ? जी हाँ... बताइए!

RUSSELL

Eat the meat, Your Highness! आप यह गोश्त खाइए और मैं दिलेर सिंग से बात करूँगा.

Puran Singh is taken aback. Elizabeth looks at Russell in disbelief while Smith observes quietly. Puran Singh tries to make light of the situation.

PURAN SINGH

Ha ha. I just told you. We're vegetarians! हम शाकाहारी हैं !

RUSSELL

जानता हूँ. सिर्फ एक गोश्त का टुकडा है. You eat it and consider your job done.

Elizabeth is embarrassed by Russell's behaviour and tries to intervene.

ELIZABETH

Andrew...

Russel gestures her to stay out of it.

RUSSELL

Eat the meat!

Meanwhile in the background, Ramsingh sets up things for a hunt-photograph. Puran Singh tentatively smiles.

PURAN SINGH

लेकिन... हमारे गोश्त खाने का मंदिर से क्या तालुक?

RUSSELL

कोई तालुक नहीं है... सिर्फ मैं आपको गाश्त खाते हुए देखना चाहता हूँ.

Puran Singh arrives at a decision.

PURAN SINGH

कॅप्टन रसल साहब, एक अँगुली का दर्द कम करने के लिए हम दूसरी अँगुली नहीं काट सकते! कर्म का धागा बाँधने को धर्म का धागा नहीं तोड सकते... I am sorry.

Russell holds his gaze on Puran Singh for a moment.

RUSSELI

Well, ठीक है ! तो फिर आप मुझे Double Tax दीजिए... क्या कहते है उसे... दुगना लगान.

PURAN SINGH

दुगना लगान ?! कॅप्टन साहब, हम यहाँ किसानों की मदद माँगने के लिए थे... उनकी मुसीबतों को कम कराने आए थे... उन्हें बढ़ाने के लिए नहीं!

RUSSELL

तो ठीक है... आप दुगना लगान अपने खजाने से दे दीजिए.

Puran Singh forces a smile.

PURAN SINGH

देने के लिए हमारे पास शाही खिताब के अलावा कुछ नहीं है... सिर्फ खुशबुओं पर जी रहें है हम... ये महल भी तो हमने पहले ही आपको तोहफे में दे दिया है!

Silence. Elizabeth avoids looking at Puran Singh as Smith conceals a smile.

RUSSELL

देखिए राजाजी, पिछले साल आधा लगान भी मैंने आपके कहने पर कुबूल किया था... वो भी देरी से... इस साल उस लगान की भरपाई करनी पडेगी. So dugnaa lagaan.

Ramsingh politely comes next to Russell and says 'Sir'. Russell gets up.

PURAN SINGH

लेकिन... अब तक बारिश नहीं हुई है.

Russell starts walking towards the photograph set-up.

RUSSELL

British Raj हिंदुस्थान की बारिश से नहीं नहाता राजाजी. बारिश या NO बारिश...मुझे तो ये छावनी बरकरार रखनी है... फौज का खर्चा उठाना है. उनका खाना-पीना... कपडे, सबकुछ - आपकी सुरक्षा के लिए!

PURAN

(mutters) लेकिन किसान देंगे कैसे?

Russell stands in pose with the hunting party. Ramsingh next to him. Russell throws his voice.

RUSSELL

Come on Rajahji, सिर्फ दुगना लगान ही तो है, और फिर, आप... गोश्त भी तो नहीं खाते!

A flash-bulb is fired.

CUT TO... (6:00)

Radhe-Krishna idol. The pujari puts some 'prasad' in a plate and gives it to a young man.

PUJARI

बाघा... ये ले परसाद.

BAGHA

हं..!

Bagha walks out of the inner room into the foyer and sits in a corner. His personal belongings are lying around. It is evident that this is his corner. A dhol lies a little away.

As Bagha is about to proceed he notices something in the distance. he gets up in disbelief, picks up his dhol and starts beating it furiously. He tries to attract the attention of the villagers who react to this drumming and turn towards the temple.

Cut to ...

8A

Village Street.

Arjan, the blacksmith comes out of his shop and moves toward Goli.

GOL

ए अर्जन... यह बाघा काहे को फुलफुलाए जा रहा है?

ARJAN

मेरी भी समझ नहीं पडा!

BHUVAN

है जरूर कोई खास बात...

ISMAIL

ुबाघा... का हुआ. ढोल काहे पीटे जा रहा है?

Bagha stops drumming

BAGHA

अ... अग... गहु... आ!

Dramatically, Bagha points to the northern sky. The villagers walk towards an opening and look in the direction. They watch in silence. The horizon is laced with thick dense clouds approaching at a great speed. Intro. Music begins. Their expressions change from curiosity to disbelief to happiness.

One villager, realising the magnitude of the event, sprints towards the village yelling...

VILLAGER

बादल... बादल... बरखा रानी आवे को है!.. मेघा... मेघा!

Bagha starts drumming furiously as he comes down the temple steps. A festive mood hits the villagers as they start to jump in joy. Children rush to the village square, followed by the womenfolk who join their men in the celebrations...

CUT TO ... (1:00)

A joyous song to welcome the rains.

The end of sorrows. The beginning of prosperity. Enough water to yield golden harvests.

Lakha tries to act sweet with Gauri. She brushes him aside smoothly. Her eyes follow Bhuvan who's persuading Mai to join the dance and sing. Lakha does not like her affinity to Bhuvan.

Goli and Bhura have forgotten their differences and dance together with Goli's children.

Bagha provides an energetic rhythm for the song, his eyes constantly on Jigni, which Gauri notices.

A rhythm so infectious that even Shambhukaka, – the oldest man of the village – cannot resist and joins the dance.

Guran dances but constantly looking skywards, suspiciously.

At the end of the first verse, the clouds are overhead.

At the end of the second verse, Bagha suddenly stops drumming and looks upwards.

The villagers stop their dance and look up.

The clouds uncover the scorching sun and travel southwards.

The villagers watch dismayed as the clouds move away from them towards the horizon.

CUT TO... (4:00)

Scene 10

Lagaan, Despair & Conflict

Village Square Ext / Day

Yashodamai breaks the mournful silence.

YASHODAMAI

हे राम... गाय खरीदी नहीं, घी की सुगंध आने लगी. बखत से पहले ही खुसियां. भगवान जाने किन करमन का फल दे रहा है?

GURAN

इस साल भी बूँद गिरने से रही.

Everyone is irritated with Guran's prediction.

ISMAIL

साला मनहूस!

HARI

कुछ भी बोलता रहता है!

ARJAN

काली जबान!

Just then, a voice is heard.

VOICE

वो ठीक कह रहा है. ना जाने कब आवेगी!

Everyone stops and looks at Shambhukaka, about 90, the oldest man in the village. Tipu is sitting next to Shambhukaka.

SHAMBHUKAKA

धुआं है यह, लपट नहीं. ये वो बादल है जो गरजते है... लेकिन बरसते नहीं... बरबादी का संदेसा लेके घूमते रहते हैं.

BHURA

बरबादी मतलब?

SHAMBHUKAKA

अंधे का सपना समझ ले, बेटा. आंख खुली, फिर अंधेरा. मुझे अब भी याद है. पिछली दफें, ४० साल पहले, यह बादल, बस अकास में आए, चले गए. और तब तीन साल बारिश नहीं हुई... धरती बस दरार... दरार - गांव छोडना पड़ा था.

GOLI

तो का अब की भी, काका?

SHAMBHUKAKA

नहीं. इस बरस तो जो अनाज है उसी में गुजर बसर हो जाएगा... मगर अगले साल अगर बूँदोने तरसाया तो हमें गाँव छोड़ना होगा उन्हींके तलाश में. राम रखवाला है. हम तो हाथ ही जोड़ सके हैं, बच्चे.

Everyone is silent as tears well up in their eyes. Gloom sets in as the villagers look at each other. Sounds of an approaching horseman. The villagers turn to see Puran Singh's emissary along with two soldiers who make a trumpet sound. The emissary unrolls a scroll and reads it aloud.

EMISSARY

सुनो... सुनो! गांववालों ऐलान सुनो. हुकुम महाराज पूरनिसंग का... बदंगी तुम्हारी. इस साल जितना गेहूँ-बाजरा चावल लगान पडता है, उसका दोगुना लगान वसूला जाएगा. ये हुकुम सारे प्रांत पर भी लागू होगां.

A mumble of protests are heard as a few farmers try to keep up with the horses 'ऐसा कैसे हो सकता है... ये तो ज्यादती है...' The villagers are devastated with this declaration The emissary rides on without encouraging dialogue. The villagers speechlessly watch the riders leave a trail of dust. The villagers are dejected, depressed, angered and emotional. Some women start crying. And so do their children. The men make feeble attempts to control them. Arjan's wife Durga suddenly rushes in the direction of the distant horses and screams.

DURGA

दोगुना लगान!.. राच्छस... गरम चिमटे से खाल खींच लेयो हमारी! हमारी हालत छुपी है का महाराज से? फिर भी दुगना लगान?

Yashodamai and a couple of women pacify her. The headman of the village, Mukhiya, about 55, watches helplessly. Ishwar raises his protest.

ISHWAR

मगर कसूर का किया है जो दुगना लगान भरें?

KAZI

पिछले साल हम बखत से लगान नहीं दे पाएं. दिए भी तो आधा.

ISMAIL

पर अब्बा, छूट तो राजाजी ही दिए थे न! बरखा की कमी से.

GOLI

दादा रे...

LAKHA

एक साल गुड अगले साल गाली. तब की सजा अब भुगतें?.. वाह रे महाराज!..

MUKHIYA

चुप कर लाखा! महाराज के खिलाफ कोई भी ऊंची नीची नहीं सुनूँगा! महाराज और उनके पुरखों ने ही हमारे सिर पर साया रखा है बरसों...

ARJAN

साया रखा है तो? ऐहसान किया? छांव देना पेड का धर्म है. हम सिर्फ इत्ता जानना चाहें हैं कि भूखे पेट कब तक उनकी मल्हारें गाएं? उनके गोदाम भरें?

MUKHIYA

बात समझा करो. यह दोगुना लगान महाराज की नहीं, गोरे सांडों की माँग है.

BHUVAN

मुखियाजी, चाहे दिहने हाथ पर धरो या बाएँ पर... लगान तो देना ही पड़ेगा! और वह तब देंगें जब हमऊ बारिश से लगान मिल जाए. अब पिछले साल का जो भी अनाज हमरे पास है, अगले साल तक वाके पेट पूज लेंगे... लेकिन यही अनाज अगर हमनें लगान में भोग दिया तो हम जीएँगे कैसे? इसलिए मैं कहता हूँ हमें राजमहल जाना होगा! और महाराज से बात करनी होगी. यह बादल उनसे छुपे नहीं है. उन्हें बताना पड़ेगा कि हम लगान नहीं दे पाएँगे!... एक दाना नहीं.

MUKHIYA

और ये... ये बताने के बाद महाराज ने मना कर दिया तो?

BHUVAN

तो... तो फिर सारी अलग अलग अँगुलियों की मुड्डी बँध जाएगी, मुखियाजी!

MUKHIYA

तुम लडोगे?!

BHUVAN

अगर जरूरत पड़ी तो वो भी...

MUKHIYA

तुम्हारी खोपडी घूम गई है, मुवन! खुद तो बरबाद होगे, हमें भी ले डूबोगे!

BHUVAN

अभी कौनसी जिन्दगी सुख भोग रही है? डूबे नाही हैं का?

MUKHIYA

वोई सही. मगर मैं पूरे गाँव पर धूल नहीं उडने दूँगा।.. समझे?

BHUVAN

का चाहते का हैं आप? घर बार बेंच दे?! गाय, भैंस और तन बेच दें दुगना लगान भरने को? कोई इन्साफ है? There is silence. The meeting is suddenly punctuated with a shout from Guran.

GURAN

लगान एकम लगान... दूनी दुगना लगान... तियां... तीन गुना लगान! हा.. हा... The villagers start murmuring amongst eachother. Ismail arrives at a decision.

ISMAIL

भुवन सही कहता है!.. ईमान लगती!

HARI

राजा की छांव में जाना ही पडेगा!

ARJAN

और रस्ता ही का है?

MUKHIYA

पर एक बात सफा सुन लो! पुरखों से लेके आज तक किसी ने ऐसी जबान नहीं खोली है! राजा के सिक्के को खोटा नहीं कहा है! हुकुम खिलाफी नहीं की है.

MAI

ये हुकुम खिलाफी नहीं है, मुखियाजी. हमरी मजबूरी है. राजा हमारा रच्छक है. हम जाए कहाँ?

MUKHIYA

खटास की एक जरा सी बूँद पूरा दूध फाड के धर देगी। यशोदामाई!गांव पर ना जाने कौन सी बिपदा आन पडे!..

SHAMBHUKAKA

इस से बड़ी भी कोइ बिपदा होगी का, संकर? अरे पैर टेढ़े हो तो रस्ता भी टेढा ढूँढना पड़ता है. बखत पड़ने पर नदिया भी बहाव बदल देवे है. कोई हल तो निकालना ही है.

CUT TO... (4:30)

The farmers arrive at the polo cricket ground. A cricket match between teams of British officers is in progress. Bhura spots the Rajah in the pavilion, who is being served some drinks. He offers a glass to Elizabeth who is seated next to him.

The villagers move towards the pavilion. They are stopped by a soldier before they can cross the boundary-line.

INDIAN SOLDIER

कहाँ जा रहे हो?

MUKHIYA

अरे एक मुस्किल आन पड़ी है. महाराजजी से मिलना बहुत जुरूरी

INDIAN SOLDIER

ठीक है. लेकिन आप मैदान में नहीं जा सकते, क्योंकि इनका खेल चालू है. आप यहीं बैठो. खेल खत्म होने तक रुकना पडेगा.

MUKHIYA

ठीक है... अरे बैठ जाओ सब!

They sit down. The farmers watch the game in amazement.

GOLI

का जाने ससुरे का खेल रहे है?

BHUVAN

हमरा गिली-डंडा है ना - वैसे ही कुछ दिखे है.

BHURA

ये गोरे बालकन का खेल काहे खेल रहें हैं ?

The umpire declares a player out, by showing his finger. Immediately, the villagers start looking upwards at the sky and wonder what the umpire was talking about.

BHURA

बादल आ गए का?

The game resumes and the batsman, Russell, hits a shot. The fielder is unable to stop the ball as it hurtles towards the boundary line where the farmers are seated.

Puran Singh's eyes follow the ball and he spots the farmers. Polite applause in the pavilion greets the shot. Elizabeth, seated next to Puran Singh is excited.

ELIZABETH

Wasn't that a wonderful shot?

PURAN SINGH

Yes, the Captain strikes the ball as well as he shoots. He's a great sportsman.

The ball reaches the farmers. Bhura picks it up and starts to examine it. Suddenly he is struck on his shoulder. Bhura yells and falls, his hand releasing the ball.

BRITISH PLAYER

You're not supposed to touch the ball!

Bhuvan defiantly moves towards the ball and picks it up. He sees the British players's hand coming down on him. He holds it. There is a scuffle.

Puran Singh suddenly stands up on seeing that. The British player has fallen, Bhuvan stands next to him. Some players, Russell among them, rush there. Puran Singh moves swiftly towards the group.

The British player gets up. Smith is the first to reach.

SMITH

Bloody darkie! Arrest him!

Two soldiers clasp Bhuvan's hands behind his back. The farmers are too terrified to protest.

Puran Singh reaches them. The farmers lie down in obeisance saying, 'महाराज की... जय!'.

PURAN SINGH

यहाँ क्या कर रहें हैं आप?

Russell watches Bhuvan.

BHUVAN

दोस छमा महाराज. हम यहाँ आपसे मिलने आए हैं, इनका ये ठुकठुक का सडियल भद्दासा खेल देखने नाही. दर्द जानना तो दूर की रही - इस गोरे ने भूरा पे हाथ छोड दिया?

Before Puran Singh can react, Russell intervenes.

PURAN SINGH

कॅप्टन रसल...

RUSSELL

तुमने जो कहा... हमें पसंद नहीं आया!

PURAN SINGH

उसे माफ कीजिए रसल साहब, ये लोग अपनी समस्या लेकर आए है... बहुत दुखी है. ये लडका तो नादान है.

RUSSELL

इतना भी नादान नहीं है. जंगल में तुम्ही थे ना ?

Bhuvan says nothing.

RUSSELL

ठीक है... छोड दो उसे! इसका फैसला खेल के बाद करेंगे.

The players disperse and Puran Singh turns to the farmers.

PURAN SINGH

हम खेल के बाद मिलते हैं!

MUKHIYA

जो अज्ञा महाराज.

Puran Singh moves towards the pavilion and the farmers sit down. All are silent. They quietly watch the game. The game progresses with a series of shots by Russell and applause from the pavilion.

Russell gets set to face another ball. He gives a look towards the farmers. He sees Bhuvan pacing. The ball is delivered. Russell strikes the ball for a sixer.

The fielders congratulate the batsmen. The game has ended. The batsmen are cheered into the pavilion.

The farmers get up, but don't move.

Puran Singh gestures to the Sentry. The Sentry waves his hand to the farmers.

Mukhiya leads them across the field.

Cut to...

11A

The farmers lie down in obeisance in front of Puran Singh.

FARMERS

महाराज की जय हो!

PURAN SINGH

अब बताओ मुखिया. क्या बात है ?

MUKHIYA

महाराज, आप जानते है माई बाप, अब तलक बरखा नहीं हुई है... जो है उसमें इस साल का बसर हो जाए, वही बहुत है. अन्नदाता, हम आपसे पैलगी करने आए हैं कि आप इस साल का... इस साल का पूरा लगान माफ कर दें, माईबाप.

PURAN SINGH

पूरा लगान माफ कर दें... देखो मुखिया, हम समझ सकते है आप लोगों पर क्या बीत रही है... लेकिन हमारे हाथ भी बँधे हुए है. ये गोरे चमडीवाले अपने बाप के सगे नहीं है... हम क्या है? आपको दुगना लगान देना ही पडेगा.

The farmers start murmuring. Russell comes out of the changing room wearing a sport sweater. He moves towards Puran Singh, his eyes on Bhuvan.

RUSSELL

कोई problem Your Highness?

PURAN SINGH

ये किसान एक खास अर्जी लेकर आए है और...

RUSSELL

वो क्या?

PURAN SINGH

वो चाहते है कि हम इस साल का लगान माफ कर दें.

Elizabeth along with a few other women is in the "European Women" tent, looks at Russell who is still focused on Bhuvan.

PURAN SINGH

देखिए, हमने उनसे ये कह दिया है कि ये नामुमकिन है.

RUSSELL

लेकिन, ये मुमकिन है.

PURAN SINGH

अच्छा!? कैसे ?

RUSSELL

हम बताता है

Russell faces the farmers. Smith and some other players also join in.

RUSSELL

ठीक है. हम लगान माफ करेगा. सारे सूबे का माफ करेगा.

The farmers cannot believe what they have just heard. Bhuvan is suspicious.

RUSSELL

लेकिन एक शर्त है.

MUKHIYA

वो का है लाटसाहिब ?

Russell points at Bhuvan.

RUSSELL

तुम! इधर आओ!

Bhuvan moves forward. Elizabeth watches Bhuvan.

RUSSELL

क्या कहा था तुमने हमारे खेल के बारे में ? What did he say... हाँ, सडियल... भद्वासा खेल है ! तुम इस खेल के बारे में क्या जानते हो ?

BHUVAN

बचपन से खेलते आ रहें हैं. हम इसे गिली-डंडा कहते हैं, और आप... ना जाने का!

RUSSELL

Cricket!! तो तुम्हारा ये कहना है कि ये cricket तुम खेल सकते हो.

BHUVAN

हाँ, असान है.

RUSSELL

ठीक है... तो मैं लगान माफ कर देता हूँ. लेकिन तुम्हें इस खेल में हमें हराना होगा. शर्त यह है कि तुम हमको इस खेल में हराओ और हम तुम्हारा लगान माफ कर देगा. You beat us in this game, and I'll cancel your tax.

Elizabeth is shocked. Smith tries to control his smile. Puran Singh is taken aback. The farmers are thrown in confusion. Russell continues to watch Bhuvan. A few officers join the meeting amused. Russell looks around and notices Elizabeth glaring at him, giving him a "you-can't-do-this" look. Russell gives her a "watch-me" look and glances at Bhuvan.

RUSSELL

लेकिन कहीं तुम हार गया तो तुम हमको triple tax, यानि तीन गुना लगान देगा. दीक है? बोलो शर्त मंजूर है?

Bhuvan does not answer. The farmers look at eachother, yet not sure.

SMITH

Sir... I think the cat's got his tongue.

A few other players snigger and crack in subdued laughter.

RUSSELL

Quiet! ठीक है... हम शर्त बढाता है... तुम हमको इस खेल में हराओगे, तो तुम्हारा इस साल का तो क्या, हम अगले साल का भी लगान माफ कर देगा... है मंजूर?

Bhuvan's mind starts racing.

MUKHIYA

भुवन, कुछ मती कहना.

ISHWAR

चुप रहना.

RUSSELL

हम शर्त और बढ़ाता है... सिर्फ एक नहीं... अगले दो साल का लगान माफ कर देगा. सिर्फ तुम्हारा ही नहीं, सारे प्रांत का! अब मंजूर है?

The British officers and players who have gathered behind Russell, have smiles on their faces. Puran Singh is impassive as the farmers murmur in hushed whispers.

ISMAIL

हमें फँसाने को गड्ढा खोदा जा रहा है, भुवन, मुखियाजी... आप बात करें.

MUKHIYA

लाट साहिब...

RUSSELL

शट अप ! तुम ! बोलो, दुगना लगान दोगे ? कि शर्त मंजूर है ?

Everyone looks at Bhuvan. The farmers, the British, Elizabeth, Puran Singh and Russell. ALl eyes are on Bhuvan.

BHUVAN

शर्त मंजूर है.

The farmers are dismayed. Elizabeth looks at the woman next to her in dishelief.

ELIZABETH

Did he agree!?

WOMAN

Yes, he did.

Elizabeth is shocked. Russell is at first surprised, but likes his guts.

RUSSELL

ठीक है. तो फिर ये तय रहा. खेल, ठीक तीन महिने बाद खेला जाएगा.

As Russell leaves we hear मायबाप, ऐसा मत कीजिए, ये तो ज्यादती है. Russell ignores their pleas and leaves the ground followed by the other officers. He crosses Elizabeth.

ELIZABETH

It is unfair.

RUSSELL

So is life!

Elizabeth gives a pitiful look to Bhuvan as she leaves. Puran Singh leaves in a daze. The farmers plead to him and go alongside his carriage.

MUKHIYA

महाराज... महाराज... हमें बचा लीजिए... हम मर जाएँगे... महाराज...

Puran Singh ignores their cries. The farmers watch in shock as everyone leaves in buggies and on horses.

Mukhiya's fury knows no bounds. Neither's does Lakha's Arjan's and Ismail's. They turn menacingly towards Bhuvan. Bhuvan stands alone facing the farmers. Angry faces.

CUT TO... (7:00)

In the village square, the farmers sit dejected. Lakha paces around giving the details of the meeting.

LAKHA

...जीत गए तो कौनो लगान नहीं होगा, लेकिन हार गए तो? तिगुना लगान भरना होगा! और ये नामुमकिन बात भुवन ने मंजूर कर दी.

SHAMBHUKAKA

ये तूने का किया भुवन?

ISMAIL

हम सबको कुए में धकेल दिया.

Mukhiya exchanges glances with the other farmers. Bhuvan stands alone in a corner.

ISHWAR

का जरूरत थी तो को सरत मंजूर करने की?

MUKHIYA

अब दुगने से तिगुना. उफ!

KAZI

अल्लाह... ये बोझ कैसे उठेगा?..

HARI

हो गया सत्यानास..

MUKHIYA

मैंने तो पहले ही कहा था. कोई बडी बिपदा आ सकती है. नई कहा था, भुवन?

BHUVAN

कोई चारा था? मैं पूछूँ था कोई चारा? का कर सकते थे हम? बताइए? दुगना लगान जबरदस्ती नहीं थी? भर सकते थे हम? भर सकते थे? ये बिपदा नहीं है मुखियाजी... मौका है मौका... मैंने जोस में हाँ नहीं की.(मुखियाजी,)चूल्हे से रोटी निकालने को चिम्टे को अपना मुँह जलाना पड़ता है. मानता हूँ हमारा पलड़ा हल्का है... लेकिन इसमें कुछ उम्मीद तो है, संभावना है और इसी संभावना को मैं सचाई में पलटना चाहता हूँ. ये खेल हैं हमरे खेत खिलयांन के लिए. भूल गए? अगर जीते तो आनेवाले दो साल भी सुखी होंगे... दो साल... जरा सोचो... दो साल कोई लगान नहीं... जानो हो इसका मतबल. मतबल... हमरा अनाज सिरफ हमरा होगा. किसीको दाना नहीं देना पड़ेगा! इससे हमरे बचों की, हमरी, सारे गाँव की खुसहाली होगी! हमरा पसीना हमरे तन में खून बनेगा.

ARJAN

साबास! छोटी छोटी आँखें, बडे बडे सुपने!

BHUVAN

हाँ, मैं सुपना देख रहा हूँ... क्योंकि सुपने वही सफल कर पावे हैं जो उन्हें देखत हैं.(सुपना ही सही, आँख खुलने तो दो!)तीन महीने कम नहीं होते अर्जन! हम खेल सीख भी सके है... हरा भी सके है.

Bhura does not respond. Bhuvan moves towards Goli.

LAKHA

तीन महीने? साल भर भी डंडी पीटो भुवन, तो यह फिरंगी खेल नहीं सीख पाओगे. डाल दिया ना साँप के बिल में हाथ -अब भुगतो.

BHUVAN

मैं जानता हूँ ये असान नहीं है, लाखा, लेकिन मुखियाजी, ये नामुमकिन भी नहीं है. मुझे आप सबका साथ चाहिए.

ISMAIL

गाँव का कोई भी आदमी तुमरे इस पागलपन में साथ नहीं देगा.

BHUVAN

लेकिन इस्माइल...

MUKHIYA

बस! बहुत भया! कान खोलके सुनले भुवन - हमें एक ही आस है. पौधे को उखाडते बखेत ऊपरसे पकड़ना पड़ता है - हम महाराज के पास फिर से जाएँगे और गुहार करेंगे

The crowd expresses support in unison. Mukhiya gets up and walks towards his house.

All start moving towards their respective houses and shops.

Bhuvan looks at Goli, Bhura, Arjan and Ismail helplessly as they walk away.

Bhuvan & Mai stand in the square with the villagers yet moving to their respective houses.

CUT TO... (2:15)

Scene 13

Bhuvan and Yashodamai - The making of a bat

Village: Bhuvan's House Ext / Night

Yashodamai sits at the entrance of the house. Bhuvan watches her while feeding the cattle.

BHUVAN

का सोच रही है, माँ?

YASHODAMAI

आज जो भया, वाई के बारे में, बेटा.

BHUVAN

माँ, तेरी कसम, मैंने जो किया... ठीक किया! मन कटता है मेरा जब हम राजा को लगान भरते हैं... और वह फिरंगियों की गंदी हथेली पर धर देता है! तू बोल माँ, धरती की छाती काटके बीज कौन बोएं हैं?.. हम बोएं! फिर सींचें कौन है? हम ही! तो फिर लगान उनकी गाठ काहे बाँध दे? गोरा साहब की बातों में अगले दो साल भी लगान माफ करने की बात थी!.. मैं का गूँगा हो जाता, माँ? तू बोल, गूँगा हो जाता?..

She keeps staring at him, tears in her eyes. Bhuvan sits before her.

BHUVAN

का सोच रही है?

Yashodamai walks up to him and runs her hand through his hair.

YASHODAMAI

यही रे कि बिल्कुल अपने बापू जैसा बोलता है. वे भी ऐसे ही जुझारू थे. खरी बोलते थे.

She wipes her tears

YASHODAMAI

अच्छा अब जा... सो जा. बोझ मती रख माथे पे. हे राम!

CUT TO ... 1:00

Scene 14 Gauri supports

Village: Bhuvan's House Ext / Night

It is a clear night. Bhuvan is watching the stars while lying on the 'khaat' in his courtyard. Just then, he hears the sound of a payal outside his gate. He gets up, curious, and walks out. He is surprised to find Gauri.

BHUVAN

गौरी? तू यहाँ का कर रही है?

GAURI

तो से ही मिलने आई थी - तोको ये बताने आई थी... कि मैं तेरे साथ हूँ. भरोसा है मोको... तेरी हिम्मत पर...

There is a pregnant pause, as she is awkward.

GAURI

बस... इत्ता ही कहने आई थी.

BHUVAN

हमम..!

She smiles at him, hesistantly retracks her steps, feels shy and runs away. Bhuvan smiles.

CUT TO... (1:15)

Village: Bhuvan's House

Ext / Day

Wood being scraped. It is Bhuvan. His carpentry tools are lying around. He is making something. Tipu an 8-year-old kid runs into Bhuvan's courtyard.

TIPU

भुवन भैय्या... भुवन भैय्या, मेरी गिल्ली टूट गई... दूसरी छील दो...

Tipu notices what Bhuvan has in his hand.

TIPU

ई का है?

BHUVAN

बताता हूँ.

CUT TO... (0:20)

Village Square Ext / Day

Another day dawns in Champaner. But things are subdued. Mukhiya is in a huddle with a group of farmers, whispering among themselves.

Non-activity. Everyone is yet reeling and dazed from the earlier day. Suddenly, there is a new sound. Patting and whistling to a slow rhythm. The villagers see that it is Bhuvan. He is striking something on his thigh as he walks. Tipu, an 8 year old kid, walks with him. Bhuvan stops in the square and looks at everyone.

Bhuvan brings his hand up to reveal a crudely made bat. His other hand carries an object which resembles a ball. He starts to bounce the ball in his hand, whistling to himself. Gauri stands outside her courtyard. Jigni is with her. Ishwar sits on a 'khaat' outside the door. Bhuvan throws his voice more than required.

BHUVAN

कोई मुस्किल नहीं है टीपू... गोरे पतलून पहनकर इस खेल को किरकट कहवे हैं... और हम लंगोटी बाँधके गिली-डंडा. हमारे बाप-दादा खेलते आ रहे हैं गिली-डंडा. अब जरा पीछे जा!

Tipu does as he is told.

BHUVAN

और पीछे... और... बस ! कुँआ में घुस जाएगा का? अब गोला पकड!

Bhuvan throws the ball at Tipu. Tipu falters and misses the catch.

BHUVAN

अरे टीपू, ठीक से पकड़, ला इधर, मैं दिखाऊँ कैसे.

The villagers watch from the corner of their eyes, while pretending to be disinterested. Bagha also watches from the temple. Tipu throws the ball towards Bhuvan, who catches it, synchronising it with a whistle. He triumphantly looks at everyone. No one meets his eyes.

BHUVAN

देखा... बहुत असान है. तू भी सीख सके है. ये खेल बिल्कुल गिली-डंडे की तरह ही है. ये ले... गोला !

Bhuvan throws the ball at Tipu. All look at Tipu, who somehow manages to catch it.

BHUVAN

साबास ! देखा ! मैंने कहा ना असान है. अब दुसरा काम... फेंक गोला.

Bhuvan brings his bat in position. The villagers, watch as Tipu throws the ball. Bhuvan swings and misses. The villagers shake their heads, exchange looks and have contempt on their faces. Bhuvan sheepishly tries to save the situation.

BHUVAN

अरे वाह वाह वाह! तू तो गोला भी बहुत अच्छा फेंकता है, टीपू.

Bhuvan looks for the ball. It has landed near Gauri.

BHUVAN

गौरी... गोला फैंक!

She looks at Jigni and her other friends. She moves towards the ball. Ishwar is alarmed. He stops her.

ISHWAR

ई का कर रही है गौरी? चल पानी गरम कर!

She looks at Ishwar glances at Bhuvan and enters the house. Bhuvan picks up the ball and goes back.

BHUVAN

हाँ! टीपू... फैंक... अब मारना कैसे हैं सो दिखाता हूँ.

Tipu takes the ball and prepares to throw. The villagers get ready for yet another humiliation. Bhuvan takes his position, shuffling his feet, fingers opening and closing on the handle, jaw hardening. Tipu throws. Everyone watches the ball travel towards Bhuvan. His bat moves far back, swings forward and strikes the ball.

The ball takes off high in the sky, the villagers watching open-mouthed, Bhura falling out of his shop to look at the flying ball. The ball flies into the temple, hits the temple bell with a resounding clang and lands next to Bagha who picks up the ball.

Bhuvan and Tipu run to the base of the temple and signal Bagha to throw the ball. He lets it go. It bounces down the steps and reaches Bhuvan. He picks it up, smiles at Bagha and turns away.

Suddenly there is a drum stroke. Bhuyan is surprised to see Bagha walk down the steps, striking his drum in single strokes. All villagers wonder. Bagha stands before him. He removes the 'dhol', takes the bat from Bhuvan's hand and gestures him to back up. The villagers are astounded.

Gauri takes this as an opportunity and looks at Ishwar.

GAURI

बापू एक बात कहूँ?

ISHWAR

का?

GAURI

मुझे लगे है... भुवन सई कर रहा है.

Ishwar thinks about it, wants to agree, but does not accept it.

ISHWAR

ठीक है, ठीक है. पानी गरम हो गया?

Bhuvan throws the ball at Bagha who manages to connect the bat with it. The ball travels along the ground and lands near Guran. Guran picks it up and walks up to Bhuvan.

GURAN

बाघा की तरह, मैं भी तुम्हारे साथ हूँ.

Bhuvan smiles at them, ruffles Tipu's hair and glances proudly at the villagers who look on.

Cut to ...

16A

Suddenly behind them in the village street, a crowd of about 100, on bullock-carts, furiously enters the square. There are about 20 turbaned men. Bhuvan looks at them questioningly, expecting trouble. They get off from the bullock carts and spread out asking questions. One person points out and says 'ये है भुवन!'

On hearing that the whole lathi-wielding mob rushes in a frenzy towards Bhuvan. Arjan, Bagha, Ishwar and Ismail anticipate trouble and move towards him, Mukhiya rushes in at the last moment and sheilds Bhuvan.

MUKHIYA

लाठी उठाने से पहले, गाँव की मरजादा का ध्यान रखो रामप्रसाद.

RAMPRASAD

हमें गाँव से नहीं, इस हरामजादे भुवन से बैर है. हम उसे सबक सिखाने आए हैं.

NAMDEO

इसकी गलती का बोझ हम क्रांहे उठाए, संकर?

Yashodamai and Gauri watch in horror.

RAMPRASAD

अबे छौने, तू होता कौन है हमारे लिए फैसला करनेवाला?

BHUVAN

मैंने जो किया है, उसीमें सबकी भलाई है.

NAMDEO

भलाई गई भाड चूले में. अब तू गोरे साब से माफी माँगेगा और ये खेल-वेल गया पोखर में... समझा?

RAMPRASAD

नई तो जानो तुमरी खैर नहीं.

MUKHIYA

धीरज से काम लो रामपरसाद... तुम जो कह रहे हो वोई होगा.

BHUVAN

लेकिन मुखियाजी...

MUKHIYA

बस भुवन, अब कोई नई... हमें महाराज के पास जाना होगा.

CUT TO ... (4:45)

A canvas. An artist is giving detail touches to Rajah Puran Singh's painting. The detail he is working on is the crown. The painting is beautifully identical with the actual setting. The farmers stand in respect on the side.

PURAN SINGH

अब बात मैंदिर, खेल या दुगना लगान की नहीं रही. बात अब अंग्रेज की, सनकी कॅप्टन रसल के अहंकार की है!

Alongwith the Mukhiya are Ramprasad, Namdeo, Bhuvan and other elders of the village.

MUKHIYA

महाराज, अब आप ही दया करें!

NAMDEO

उस गोरे साब से दुबारा बात कर लें सरकार.

RAMPRASAD

क्षमा करें, महाराज. भुवन छौना है अभी. जोस में था. खौलते पानी में तो चेहरा भी दिखाई न देवे है, महाराज.

Puran Singh looks at them from the corner of his eyes.

PURAN SINGH

ये जोश होश की बात नहीं है! इसने तुम सबकी तरफ से अँग्रेजों को ललकारा है.

NAMDEO

यह गोरे साहब से माफी माँगने को तैयार है... और हम सब भी.

BHUVAN

बीस कोडे मार ले महाराज... मैं कोई माफी नहीं माँगूंगा!

PURAN SINGH

अब तो माफी का सवाल ही नहीं! जो कर दिया उसे भुगतना पडेगा.

MUKHIYA

तो अब का करें हजूर?

PURAN SINGH

एक ही काम कर सकते हो... उनका खेल सीखो!

The Mukhiyas on hearing this finality are dejected.

CUT TO... (00:45)

Englishmen playing cricket. This view is through a lot of foliage and from a little height. A batsman plays the ball. A fielder runs, collects the ball and throws it back to the wicket keeper.

The P.O.V. is of Bhuvan, Tipu, precariously perched atop a tree, behind the boubdary line and intently watching the game alongwith Bagha and Guran. Tipu is confused.

TIPU

भुवन भैय्या, ये बाकी के सब काहे खडे है मैदान में?

BHUVAN

ठीक गिली-डंडे की तरह... गिली पकडने... मतलब गोला पकडने के लिए.

The batsman tries to cut a delivery and is caught behind. The umpire raises his finger signalling 'out'.

TIPU

वो अकास की तरफ अँगुली काहे उठा रहा है?

Guran cranes his neck to look up at the sky. So do the others. It is a clear sky. Guran makes guttural sounds.

BHUVAN

यहीं मैं समझने की कोसिस कर रहा हूँ.

GURAN

(looks up) बरखा माँग रहा है का? (angry) अपनी अम्मा को याद कर रहा हैगा! ऊपर बैठी है न!

Tipu controls his laughter as he exchanges a look with Bagha.

Elizabeth is seated in the pavilion. A shot is played. Elizabeth follows the ball through her binoculars as it reaches a fielder near the boundary line. The fielder throws the ball back to the bowler. She does a double-take on noticing some movement up on a tree behind the boundary. She gets curious and on a concentrated look discovers Bhuvan.

She excuses herself and walks out of the pavilion. She casually starts to stroll along the boundary line. She walks towards the tree where Bhuvan and his gang are hiding.

Bhuvan notices her

BHUVAN

ए... वो गोरी इधर ही कोआ रई है.

Bhuvan gestures everyone to be quiet. Guran's branch makes a sound when he takes his feet up..

Elizabeth reaches the tree. The branch breaks and Guran falls down.

Elizabeth is startled. She shrieks. A player in the distance looks at her. Tipu, Bagha and Bhuvan jump down. Elizabeth composes herself on seeing Bhuvan. The player calls out from the distance.

PLAYER

Miss! What happened? The darkies bothering you?

ELIZABETH

It's alright! They're farmers... I know them. Thank you. Carry on with your game.

PLAYER

You sure, Miss?

ELIZABETH

Yes, of course!

The player rejoins the game.

Elizabeth tries to make conversation.

ELIZABETH

I know what you were doing up on that tree. You were trying to know the game.

BHUVAN

नहीं... नहीं... मेमसाब, हम तो ये खेल समझने पे लगे हैं.

ELIZABETH

Oh! I thought you were trying to know the game...

Bhuvan looks at Bagha, Guran and Tipu who look back equally baffled.

TIPU

भुवन भैय्या, का कह रही है?

BHUVAN

मुझे लगे है वो हमें जाने के लिए कह रही है... ठीक है मेमसाब, हम जाते है.

They start to move. Elizabeth gestures to them.

ELIZABETH

Wait! Wait!!

She looks at the pavilion, spots Ramsingh and calls out.

ELIZABETH

Ramsingh!

She smiles at Bhuvan.

ELIZABETH

I'm going to need help to understand what you are saying and to make you understand what I have to say.

Bhuvan forces an awkward smile as if he has understood everything. Ramsingh reaches them.

RAMSINGH

Yes Memsahib? What can I do?

ELIZABETH

I want you to tell them that I would like to help them know the game.

RAMSINGH

Yes Memsahib! मेमसाब कह रही है कि इस खेल को समझने में मदद...

He halts. He calls Elizabeth away from them.

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब... लेकिन आपके भाईसाहब को अगर पता चला तो... I mean Russell Sahib will be angry...

ELIZABETH

Can I trust you, Ramsingh?

RAMSINGH

Of course, Memsahib!

ELIZABETH

No one should know about this.

RAMSINGH

Alright, Memsahib (mutters in disbelief) किसीको पता नहीं चलेगा. (walks towards Bhuvan) मेमसाब, कह रही है, कि इस खेल को समझने में वो तुम्हारी मदद करना चाहेंगी.

Bhuvan is surprised and happy. But is immediately suspicious.

BHUVAN

लेकिन काहे? यह भी तो गोरी है.

RAMSINGH

Memsahib, the man wants to know why you would want to do this as you too are British.

ELIZABETH

Tell him, because I know what happened with them was unfair and I want to give them a fair chance.

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब कह रही हैं कि वो जानती है, तुम्हारे साथ ज्यादती हुई है और इसलिए वो तुम लोगों को बराबर का मौका देना चाहती हैं...

Bhuvan's face brightens up upon hearing this. He looks at Elizabeth ignoring Ramsingh.

BHUVAN

हमें खुसी होगी... सुक्रिया !

Guran smiles and rolls his eyes.

GURAN

का बात है!

RAMSINGH

He'll be glad to receive your help and thanks you in return.

ELIZABETH

Tell him I'll meet him tomorrow, same time. But not here. And certainly not in the village. Some other. quiet place, maybe?

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब कल मिलेंगी.. इसी समय... लेकिन यहाँ नहीं और गाँव में भी नहीं... कोई दूसरी जगह है? अलग?

Bhuvan observes Elizabeth as Ramsingh translates.

BHUVAN समझ गया... हमम... गाँव के नजदीक जो टीला है... वा के पास

RAMSINGH

हाँ, ठीक है. He says you can meet him behind the hill, close to the village. I know the place.

ELIZABETH

Okay... What's his name?

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब तुम लोगों का नाम जानना चाहती है.

Bhuvon?

BHUVAN

हाँ... अब सही फूटी!

Everyone agrees.

ELIZABETH

My name is Elizabeth.

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब का नाम है एलिजाबेथ.

BHUVAN

ऐ... ली... और क्या? बेथ... बाप रे! नाम लो तो ससुरी जीभ टेढी हो जाए.

GURAN

(nods and smiles furiously) अच्छा नाम है... अच्छा नाम है... जो भी है!

Elizabeth laughs. Bhuvan joins his hands as they leave.

BHUVAN

नमस्ते!

Elizabeth watches them go and softly repeats his name.

ELIZABETH

Bhuvon!

CUT TO... (4:00)

Village street / Goli's house Ext / Night

It is night. Goli is playing with his kids in his courtyard. They have just finished dinner. His wife is cleaning up.

Bhuvan alongwith Bagha, Guran, Tipu and Gauri watch from a distance.

GAURI

भुवन... वो कब्बी नई मानेगा...

BHUVAN

मानेगा... एक तरकीब है...

Bhuvan walks towards Goli's house and enters the compund.

19A

Goli's house.

Goli is surprised to see him and avoids eye-contact. Bhuvan greets Goli's wife and taps the head of his kids.

BHUVAN

पैलागी भाभी... का कर रहा है सैतान, तो गोली, दाना-पानी जीमा?

GOLI

हॉ...

Goli eyes him intermittently as Bhuvan sits comfortably on the 'khatiya'.

GOLI'S WIFE

सारा दिन दिखाई न दिए, भुवन भैय्या?

BHUVAN

का करू भाभी... तैयारी में जुटा पडा था.

GOLI

कैसी चल रही है तेरी खेल की तैयारी ?

BHUVAN

सुरुवात है... धागा पकड रहे हैं.

GOLI

जानत है, गाँववाले खिल्ली उडात रहेन! बोले, का साथी मिले है भुवन को. बाघा और गुरन. एक को ढोल पीटने के अलावा कुछ आवे नहीं... और दूसरा पागलों की तरह आँखे फाडें घूरत रहेन.

Goli feels someone sitting next to him and gets a shock to see Guran and Bagha staring him in the eye.

GOLI

नईं नईं... ऐसा गाँववाले कहिन... राम राम... हम नहीं.

BHUVAN

इनके अलावा एक गोरी मेम भी हमरे साथ है. खेल सिखाएगी.

GOLI

गोरी मेम? का हाँक रहा है?

Gauri walks up to Goli's wife and takes the child from her and cradles her.

BHUVAN

सची! पूछ ले इन से.

GOLI

गौरी, का ई सच है?

Gauri gives a jealous look at Bhuvan and then fakes excitement.

GAURI

हाँ... है कोई गोरी मेम्!

GOL

मतबल यह कि तू सचमुच खेलोगे?

BHUVAN

और चारा का है? हमरे पास मेरे जित्ता खेत भी तो नाही है कि एक टुकडा फाड दें.

GOLI

का माने? मैं काहे बेचूँ अपना खेत?

BHUVAN

दुगना लगान का नानी के घर से देगा?.. खैर... चलता हूँ.

As Bhuvan proceeds to get up, Goli stops him.

GOLI

ए भुवन... मैं काम आ सकूँ हूँ?

BHUVAN

और का तेरी भैंस काम आवेगी? मरे तू ही तो सबसे जादा काम का है!

GOLI

सो कैसे?

BHUVAN

अब जैसे गोफन मुरियाता है वैसे ही गोला. का निसाना है तेरा!.. धाँय से!

GOLI

तो... तो का सचमुच हमरा लगान माफ होगा? हम भरपेट जीमेंगे?!. सुपने सच होंगे? नई नई... तू गीली चुटिकया में नमक पकड रहा है.

BHUVAN

भरोसा कर... मैं सच कह रहा हूँ!

Goli is flushed with emotion.

Guran starts playing the 'ektara', his string instrument. A very upbeat rhythm is added by Bagha.

CUT TO... (2:00)

Anii Khan Productions Put Lite

Scene 20: Playback Song Three Success!

Goli's house / Village Square / Cantonment Int-Ext / Night

Guran proclaims 'हर संत कहे, साधु कहे - सच और साहस है जिसके मन में, अंत में जीत उसीकी रहे.'

The song is full of hopes and dreams.

Bhuvan joins the song. Gauri also sings expressing her insecurity about Gori Mem.

The song shifts from inside the house to the yard where Yashodamai watches.

The rest of the village also watches from closed doors and windows.

Jigni would love to be a part of it, but she dare not, as she exchanges a look with Arjan, her brother.

As a cut away we also see Elizabeth learning to speak the language from Ramsingh.

Ishwar finally accepts the idea of supporting Bhuvan.

As the song ends, Lakha simmering with anger, watches Bhuvan and Gauri together.

CUT TO... (5:00)

Scene 21

Lakha proposes - Gauri refuses

Lakha's courtyard / Gauri's House Int - Ext / Afternoon

Lakha stands in his courtyard looking impatiently in the direction of Gauri's house. Ishwar walks out of the house, meets another man coming in.

ISHWAR

ए गौरी, भीमा को पीठदरद का लेप दे देना!

Ishwar leaves and Bheema enters the house. Lakha gets an idea. He slashes his palm with an axe and starts towards her house. Bheema walks out as Lakha enters.

Cut to ...

21A

Gauri's house. Gauri sees him.

GAURI अब, तुझे का दरद है

Lakha looks at her tentatively.

Lakha shows her the wound.

GAURI

हाय राम... फिर से हाथ कटवा लिया?

She leads him to a medicine cabinet and starts nursing the wound. Lakha watches her and finds the right moment.

LAKHA

गौरी, कल रोत मैंने बहुत सोची और उडे दिन घुमड आए... याद हैं, बचपन में भी कैसे अल्लड रहा करता था... भुवन से लडना, तुझे चिढाना, खेलत पे गिली छुपा देना... (laughs) ऐसा लगे है जुग बीत गया, साथ खेले... है ना?

Gauri takes notice.

LAKHA

देख. मुझे भी लगे है कि भुवन जो कर रया है, सई कर रया है. मैंने अब बाँध ली है... खेलूँगा!.. वा का साथ दूँगा!..

GAURI

सची? तो चल मेरे साथ!..

She places a couple of boxes in the cabinet.

LAKHA

एक बात और कैनी है!

She turns to face him.

GAURI

हाँ... बोल..!

LAKHA

गौरी, तेरी कसम, तुझे छुटपनेसे देखा है... छुटपनेसे बहुत चाहा है! सारा सारा दिन तेरे बारे में ही सोचा करूँ हूँ. रात में पलक न झपके है. मैं का करूँ? मैं तुझे चाहू हूँ गौरी. फेरे घूम ले मेरे साथ. सेन्दूर डाल ले मेरी चुटकी का. मन की रानी बना के रखुँगा, कसम से! बस... इत्ती ही...

She keeps staring at him point blank as he expresses his hearts desire.

GAURI

कह ली बात? अब मेरी सुन ले. ये कब्बी नहीं होगा.

She walks off towards the kitchen sink and picks up a food bundle. Lakha walks behind her.

काहे ?(क्यों?)क्योंकि तू भुवन से प्यार करे है?

जब जाने है तो फिर उलझ काहे रहा है?

She walks out of the house. Lakha follows her.

LAKHA

समज ले... भुवन जो कर रया है वा में मुँह की खाएगा.

Gauri locks the door and looks at him sharply.

GAURI

अच्छा?! अब्बी तो कुछ और फेंक रहा था?.. साथ दूँगा!

LAKHA

देख गौरी... मैं लकडहारा हूँ. एक कुल्हाडी में पेड धाँय से जमीन पे!.. समझी?

GAURI

तो तू भी सुन ले... जिसे पेड समझ रहा है न वो चट्टान है चट्टान! कुल्हाड़ी से पत्थर काटेगा? धत्त!..

She sarcastically smiles and walks out of her courtyard. Just then, marching troops pass by in the village street. Lakha frustrated watches her go, as the troops cover and uncover his face.

CUT TO... (2:15)

Practise Field Ext / Day

A small hill. Next to it is an open ground. In the distance, the village can be seen. Ishwar has the bat in hand while Goli throws the ball. Ishwar connects and Bagha fields. Tipu sits crouched in the field. Bhuvan guides them.

BHUVAN

वा ईसरकाका! वा!! गई अंग्रेज की भैस पानी में!

Tipu is restless.

TIPU

वो गोरी आई नहीं अभी तक.

Gauri reaches them.

GAURI

ले... मैं आ गई!

BHUVAN

अहं! वह तेरी नहीं... गोरी मेम की बाट जोह रहा है!.. गौरी नहीं... गोरी!

Gauri does not like the remark.

TIPU

वो आ गई...

A carriage driven by 2 horses appears. Everyone prepares to receive the 'Gori Mem'. Their eagerness gets to Gauri.

GAURI

अच्छा भुवन ये बता, वा भुतनिया तुमरे सात देवे को तैय्यार कैसे हो गई?

Bhuvan glances at Gauri understanding the implication of the question. Tipu pipes up as the carriage comes closer.

TIPU

सीधी सी बात... भा गया भुवन!

GAURI

ऐसा?

The carriage halts.

BHUVAN

चुप टीपू... तू बहुत फुदकता है!..

A young 14 year old bugy rider controls the horses. Ramsingh who was sitting next to him, gets off and opens the door. Gauri prepares herself with nose in the air to receive the Memsahib. Elizabeth gets off in all her Victorian splendour. Gauri too is mesmerised by her beauty. Elizabeth walks towards them and smiles at Gauri who is surprised and finds herself smiling back at her. Elizabeth joins her palms and speaks with an accent.

ELIZABETH

नमस्ते!

Everyone is taken aback but they quickly reciprocate.

EVERYONE

नमस्ते... नमस्ते.

Elizabeth points at Gauri.

ELIZABETH

ये कौन है?

BHUVAN

अरे! आप तो जल्दी ही सीख गई हमारी भासा.

ELIZABETH

हाँ! रामसिंग सिखाया. ये कौन है ?

BHUVAN

ये इसरभाई... और ये गोली... और ये गौरी है. सब हमरे साथ है.

ELIZABETH

फिर मिलेंगे...

They are shocked.

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब आप गलत बोल गई. Wrong line. बोलिए - मिलकर खुशी हुऔ.

ELIZABETH

Oh God, sorry. मिलकर खुशी हुई.

All laugh.

ISHWAR

हमें भी...

ELIZABETH

All right, Bhuvan. Tell me, what do you know about the game?

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब पूँछ रही है - तुम खेल के बारे में क्या जानते हो?

BHUVAN

कुछ खास नहीं... ६ डंडियाँ होवें हैं... तीन इस तरफ तीन उस तरफ... दो लोग हाथों में फलियाँ लेकर उन डंडियों के आगे खड़े रहवें है... एक मानूस दौड़ के डंडियों के पास से गोला फैंकता है. फलीवाला फली से गोले को मारता है और फिर सब भागने लगते है. उनमें से एक गोला उठाता है और जिस मानूस ने पहले गोला फेंका था उसके पास वापस फैंकता है... जो फिर से दौड़कर...

Ramsingh is baffled with this speedy onslaught of information and turns to Elizabeth.

RAMSINGH

Sorry Memsahib, I can't translate all that.

ELIZABETH

No need. I understood most of that. He knows nothing. Tell him - cricket is played by two teams...

RAMSINGH

क्रिकेट दो दलों के बीच खेला जाता है - जैसे तुम्हारा और अंग्रेजों का...

ELIZABETH

Each team has...

RAMSINGH

हर दल में..

ELIZABETH

11 players...

RAMSINGH

११ खिलाडी होते हैं.

ELIZABETH

There are three aspects to it. Batting, bowling and fielding

RAMSINGH

इस खेल के तीन खास हिस्से होते है - पहला बल्लेबाजी...

BHUVAN

बल्लेबाजी? माने?

RAMSINGH

बल्लेबाजी मतलब बल्ले से मारना... बल्ला यानि थापी...

BHUVAN

अ... च्छा... थापी!

All exchange knowing looks.

RAMSINGH

फिर - गेंदबाजी, यानि गेंद को फैंकना... गेंद यानि गोला... और तीसरा - क्षेत्ररक्षण, यानि लपकना - गेंद को boundary -पार जाने से रोकना...

BHUVAN बांड्री... बांड्री (मतलब?) मतब्रुस ?

ISHWAR

इतनी गाढी भासा मेरा ताऊ न समझ सके! जाने का बडी बडी फेंक रहा है.

RAMSINGH

boundary-पार यानि... Memsahib, what's a boundary line ?

ELIZABETH

Let me show you.

Elizabeth draws a circle on the ground and proceeds to explain.

Throughout all this, Gauri has been watching Bhuvan listening to Elizabeth attentively. She observes Elizabeth's hair, her skin, the way she has dressed up. For a horrible moment the thought of losing Bhuvan to the Memsahib crosses her mind – She is brought out of her reverie by Elizabeth.

ELIZABETH

Gauri... Gauri.

GAURI

हाँ जी.

ELIZABETH

What happened?

BHUVAN ,

का हुआ?

GAURI

कुछौ नहीं!

ELIZABETH

बस... आज के लिए बहुत है.

BHUVAN

अरे हाँ! मेमसाब, कौनसा दल जीता है, सो कैसे पता चलेगा... आखिर में पगडी किसके सर पर बँधती है?

RAMSINGH

He wants to know... which team wins?

ELIZABETH

(in chorus with Ramsingh) Which team wins? The team that makes the maximum runs wins.

RAMSINGH

जो दल सबसे ज्यादा दौड बनाएगा... वो जीतेगा...

Bhuvan realises the target of the game and so do the others.

GURAN

रपा रप है! हम दौडते रहेंगे.

Ramsingh is restless.

RAMSINGH

Memsahib, I think we should leave now... it is getting late.

Elizabeth gets up, followed by others.

ELIZABETH

मुझे जाना है...

BHUVAN

हाँजी... अल्लीजा...और बेथ बेथ... धत्त, जीभ पलट गई... मेमसाब हम आपको अल्लीजा मेमसाब कहें तो?

ELIZABETH

ठीक है!

TIPU

आप कल आवेंगी न?

ELIZABETH

हाँ... now is the time to say 'फिर मिलेंगे'....correct?

All laugh. She gets into the carriage and leaves.

Cut to...

22A

Bhuvan calls out to everyone.

BHUVAN

चलो, सुरू करते हैं, लेकर परभू का नाम...

Bhuvan throws the ball. Guran, Bagha, Goli and Ishwar stand in the field at a distance. The ball lands in Bagha's hands, quickly bounces out and falls next to him.

BHUVAN

गेंद को लपकने की जुगत करो. उसे गिरने मती दो. पहले से तैयार रहो.

ISHWAR

भुवन, मेमसाब बोली थी कि दल मे ११ लोग होने चाहिए - और हम तो सिरफ ५ हैं.

Gauri opens the food packet. Starts making a roll.

GAURI

५ काहे? मैं भी तो हूं... जो कुछ वो गोरी मेम कर सके है वो मैं भी तो कर सकूँ हूं!

She gives the roll to Bhuvan. Bhuvan breaks it in two and gives her one half.

BHUVAN

ठीक है गोरी.... ५ नहीं छ:.. इसरकाका जिस तरह आपने गाँव के बारे में सोचा है, उसी तरह और भी लोग सोचेंगे और आ जाएँगे - या फिर हम उन्हें खींच लाएँगे.

GURAN

ए गोली, ले पकड

Guran yells out to Goli as he throws the ball towards him. Goli waits with palms wide open before his face.

Gauri, Bhuvan and Ishwar watch as the ball passes through his palms and hits him on the forehead. He collapses, dazed. Gauri, Bhuvan and Ishwar smile while, Guran, Bagha and Tipu have a hearty laugh. Goli feels further embarrassed, gets up enraged, spots the ball and throws it towards Guran angrily. The ball is thrown with so much force that it travels beyond Guran and Baghadisappears behind a small mound. Everyone starts to laugh.

BHUVAN

तुम सब हँस काहे रहे हो. गोली, कोई बात नहीं. तुमरे सरीर में हम सबसे जादा ताकत है, लेकिन उतनी ही लगाओ जितनी जरूरत हो.

Cut to...

22B

Suddenly they hear curses from behind the mound. Hens and chickens fly upwards. Bhura emerges on top holding the ball in his hand. He is in a rage.

BHURA

ई गोला किसने फैंका ?

TIPU

गोलीचाचा ने.

Bhura throws the ball in anger and rushes towards Goli.

BHURA

आज तो मैं गोली नहीं छोडूँगा.

Bhuvan smiles as Ishwar moves towards them.

ISHWAR

ओफ ओ... इनके झगडे कब खत्म होंगे मरे ? अरे भूरा...

BHURA

ईसरभाई... आज आप बिल्कुल बीच में मती पडना...निपट लेने दो!

While watching Bhura, Bhuvan has an idea. He takes the ball from Tipu and looks at Gauri.

BHUVAN

ये है... अपना सातवाँ खिलाडी !

Gauri looks at him surprisingly as he screams Bhura's name and throws the ball at him. Bhura reacts to the call instinctively and catches the ball.

BHUVAN

ईसरकाका, आपने देखा ? ऐसे पकडते हैं गेंद को. का बात है, भूरा !... जीता रह बिना पानी के!

Ishwar guesses Bhuvan's plan. He also takes part in this scheme.

ISHWAR

अच्छा, तो ऐसे गुपचते है.

BHUVAN

तो फिर... ए भूरा, वापस गुपच कर दिखा इन लोगों को... और खासकर इस गोली को, इसे तो बिल्कुल पकडना न आवे... ए, सब लोग... थोडा बगली काटो !

Everyone moves aside leaving Bhura alone.

Gauri smiles as she watches Bhuvan's tactic.

Bhura stands alone wondering what was the great thing he did. Bhuvan throws the ball with greater speed this time. Bhura once again catches it perfectly. Everyone starts applauding. Bhura is confused about how he should react to this new-found importance.

ISHWAR

अरे भूरा... ये तूने कहाँ से सीखा ?

BHUVAN

मैं बताता हूँ. गेंद तो ससुरी सीधी-सीधी आवे है. लेकिन मुर्गियाँ पकड़ने के लिए बदन में मरी फुरती होनी चाहिए, जो इसमें है... और अब भूरा ही हम सब को सिखाएगा... क्यों रे भूरा ?

Bhura unknowingly becomes a part of the team. He looks at them, perplexed.

BHURA

सो तो चौकस है... लेकिन...

BHUVAN

लेकिन का ?

BHURA

मेरी मुर्गियाँ ?

Cut to a wide shot of the field and hillock to see everyone rushing in zig-zag fashion to gather his hens.

CUT TO... (6.30)

Scene 23 Bhuvan teases Gauri

Village: Bhuvan's House

Int-Ext / Dusk

Gauri massages oil on Yashodamai's feet. Mai is relieved.

YASHODAMAI

बस गौरी बेटा बस!

GAURI

होई गया न, अब आपका पैर का दरद कम हो जाएगा.

YASHODAMAI

हो गया पगली... तेरे हाथ बहुत गुनी हैं.

Gauri feels elated. Yashodamai gets up, walks to the kitchen shelf, empties a portion of the food in another container, wraps it and gives it to Gauri.

YASHODAMAI

ये ले. ईसरभाई के लिए,

GAURI

बापू के लिए

YASHODAMAI

देख बेटी, तेरी माँ तो सुहागन सुरग चढ गई! और तू सारा दिन भुवन के साथ खेल की तैय्यारी मैं लगी रहती है. अब ईसर भाई दुकान संभालें कि चूल्हा फूंकें?... कि खेलें? ये ले और अब देर मती कर... जा!

Gauri is touched. She smiles and walks out of the house.

Cut to ...

23B

Courtyard.

In the courtyard she comes across Bhuvan who has just returned.

GAURI

ए भुवन... बात सुन!

Bhuvan decides to tease her.

BHUVAN

अब गुरन ने का कह दिया ? ...ब्याह नहीं होगा?

GAURI

धत्! गुरन नाहीं... मरे लाखा ने...

BHUVAN

लाखा ने ?वह भी भविस बांचने लगा?

GAURI

ओफ ओ... पकर पकर मती कर! वह बोला है की मुझे टूट के परेम करे हैं! हल्दी रचावेगा मेरे साथ!

BHUVAN

का बोली? वाह वाह! गुरन की कही सच निकली!

Gauri is shocked. Bhuvan speaks as if in a trance.

BHUVAN

तो गुरन ने तुझे लाखा के साथ फेरे बोले थे! पर वाके घर नीम का पेड है? नहीं है! खैर, पेड कही से उखाडके जमा देंगे! भैंसें..? ...हैं! बकरिया नहीं! हाँक लावेंगी किसी की! उहं.... तू सुखी रहेगी! जीती रह जन्नो!

Gauri cannot take it any more.

GAURI

माई... माई !

Yashodamai answers from inside.

YASHODAMAI

तू अभी तक गई नहीं ? का हुआ ?

GAURI

ये मेरी खिल्ली उडा रहा है.

YASHODAMAI

भुवन, तू उसे छेड मती!

BHUVAN

छेडे कौन है, माई! खुसी मना रहा हूँ. पींऽऽऽ (शहनाई action)

GAURI

तू मोको काहे छेडता है?

BHUVAN

चुप! बात सुन! माला देखी है न? हार गूथंने को फूल सुई से छेदा जावें हैं की नहीं? बोल!

GAURI

तो मैं माला हूँ?

BHUVAN

नहीं... सूई, जो चुबती रहवें है.

Gauri gets frustrated.

GAURI

आज के बाद मैं तोसे बात नहीं करूँगी. और मैदान पर तेरे कदम भी नहीं रखूँगी.

Bhuvan smiles as he watches her go.

YASHODAMAI

भुवन... खाना परोस दिया है... आजा!

He loses his smile as he remembers what she has told him.

BHUVAN

लाखा!

FADE OUT... (2.30)

Fade In...

Another palace in the heart of a busy town, with the Union Jack fluttering on the dome. A legend flashes on the screen - British HQ Central Provinces

Three uniformed British officers, brass shining, welcome Russell. Col. Boyer, about 55, sits behind the table. Major Cotton, about 53 years old, leans on the table and Major Warren, 50, stands at the window.

BOYER

Come in, Captain Russell!

Russell enters, salutes and stands at attention.

BOYER

At ease, Captain. You know Major Cotton, and that's Major Warren. Please take a seat.

Russell takes a seat without a word. The three Officers exchange a look.

BOYER

What is this we hear, that you are going to cancel the tax of the farmers in Champaner if they beat you in a game of Cricket... is it true?

RUSSELL

Yes Col. Boyer... sir. It is!

BOYER

What do you think you're here for? To play games?

Major Warren, who was looking out of the window, turns.

WARREN

Let me remind you that you are working here for Her Majesty the Queen. Your job is to ensure the smooth running of your province.

RUSSELL

Pardon me, sir. But that's exactly what I am doing.

COTTON

Bloody hell you're doing that! We have also heard that if you lose this... this 'match', you will cancel their taxes for the next three years!

WARREN

Not just Champaner, but the entire province!

RUSSELL

But they won't win.

WARREN

You're missing the bloody point. Do you realise Captain Russell, that we could have on our hands a bloody situation, where there will be Cricket matches all over the damned subcontinent in order to cancel the bloody tax!

RUSSELL

But there is one thing you don't know. If they lose, which they will, they will have to pay the Queen, three times the tax.

COTTON

This is preposterous! The fool wants the Government to become some kind of a bookie with whom he can place his wagers! What will you have us do next? Race horses?

BOYER

This is the most ridiculous thing I've ever heard of. Captain Russell, the British Empire cannot function according to the whims and fancies of officers like you. You jolly well understand that if you win, you will have made a narrow escape. But if you lose, you... will pay the 3 years' taxes for Champaner and the entire province from your bloody pocket. And you will also be packed off to Central Africa.

Is that clear?

Russell pauses for a moment but does not bat an eyelid.

RUSSELL

Yes Sir

BOYER

That'll be all! You may leave.

Russell gets up, clicks his heels and exits. Major Cotton lights a cigar.

COTTON

He is bloody stupid...

WARREN

...and bloody eccentric too.

BOYER

Got to watch out! Power has gone to his head!

COTTON

Good thing his father's got plenty of money. We're safe.

Warren smirks.

WARREN

Heh... heh... I say, old chaps! I would love to see Russell play his cricket in Central Africa.

COTTON

Ha... ha... It'll be a jolly good laugh!

All laugh.

CUT TO... (2:30)

Russell beats Arjan

Cantonment: Stable

Ext / Day

A group of horses enter the cantonment led by Russell.

RUSSELL

Whoa... whoa...

As the horses pass we pan to see, Arjan fixing a horse-shoe. Smith walks out from the office to receive Russell who dismounts from the horse, quite furious.

RUSSELL

Is that the way a soldier behaves... You're supposed to click your heels when an officer passes.

SOLDIER

I just did that sir.

RUSSELL

I didn't hear it.

The soldier clicks his heels louder this time.

RUSSEL

That's better.

Russell walks up to Smith.

SMITH

I imagine the meeting did not go the way you expected, sir.

RUSSELL

Damned well right it didn't... The senile old hats want to teach me how to run the show. They have lost the spirit of adventure with age. So what's wrong with a little fun and games along with the lagaan.

Arjan reacts to the word lagaan and looks at Russell. He strikes his hammer in the wrong place. The horse neighs in pain.

Russell turns to look at Arjan who is trying to control the neighing horse.

RUSSELL

Hey... how dare you hurt my horse?

He charges at Arjan and starts to beat him up.

RUSSELL

मेरे घोडे को तकलीफ दिया. अब तुम लोग नहीं बचेगा... तुम लोगों से इतना लगान वसूल करेगा की पहनने को कपडा नहीं रहेगा. तुम साला गुलाम लोग हमारी जूती के नीचे ही रहेगा.

Arjan is hurt but gets up to face Russell.

ARJAN

तल्ली कित्ती भी मोटी होए सरकार... घिसत जरूर है! फिर कीलें चुभै लगती हैं!

RUSSELL

Ramsingh, ask him to leave before I kill him.

RAMSINGH

मौत को काहे बुला रहे हो अर्जन? फौरन निकल जाओ.... जल्दी!

Arjan leaves in a daze, frustrated, helpless, angry and shocked, all at the same time.

CUT TO... (1.45)

anii knan Productions

Arjan joins - Gauri jealous

Practise field Day / Ext

Bhuvan puts three sticks vertically in the ground, sits down to check the distances between them.

Through the sticks, behind in the distance, he sees Arjan followed by a group of 15 villagers walking towards him. Jigni is also excitedly keeping pace with him. Bagha, Guran, Goli, Bhura, Ishwar and Tipu also notice. They are all working towards creating a smooth pitch.

Bhuvan gets up and faces a bruised Arjan

BHUVAN

अर्जन... का हुआ?

The others get up and walk towards them.

ARJAN

हमें लागत है भैय्या, हम अंधे रहे! बेमगज! अब हम तुमरे साथ हैं!... कौनो काम आ सकत होए तो बोलो... और ये लोग भी!

FAT VILLAGER

हम हऊ खेलेंगे! हां

BHUVAN

ये तो खुसालीवाली बात है... मुड्डी बन रही है!

Bagha plays the dhol and everyone cheers. Familiar faces. 'वा दीनाचाचा', 'आओ अनवर...', 'अच्छा है'

Bhuvan is at first happy but now unsure as he sees the crowd. One of them with a big tummy, one is stick thin, another is drunk and some are fairly old.

Bhuvan moves towards an old villager.

BHUVAN

दीनाचाचा...हम पर आपका असीस बहुत है! अब इस उमर में...

DINA

हम बूढे लागत हैं का! अभी जोरे बटोरे तीन बीसी के हैं! और ये ईसर जवान हैं का? अब तुम आजमा के देख लियो कि गाढी दाल हम खाएं हैं की ईसर!

Everyone protests to Bhuvan and there is chaos as Ishwar and Dina also have an argument.

Bhuvan stops them.

BHUVAN

ठीक है... ठीक है... जानने का एक ही तरीका है...

ALL

का?

BHUVAN

सब लोगन मैदान का एक चक्कर दौड़ के आओ! गाढी दाल बच जाएगी!

Everybody looks at the size of the ground. All agree.

DINA

ईसर भी दौडिहैं! हां!

The whole group starts the run at the edge of the field. A buggy arrives and halts. Elizabeth gets off followed by Ramsingh. She notices the strange voice.

BHUVAN

नमस्ते मेमसाब! आईये!

ELIZABETH

नमस्ते. वो लोग क्या कर रहे हैं?

BHUVAN

परीच्छा चल रही है की कौन कौन खेल दल में रहने लाइक हैं!

ELIZABETH

अरे वाह! मगर भुवन ये लोग तुमारे काम के नई हो सकते!

BHUVAN

जानता हूँ मेमसाहब. मगर उनके मन में हौसला तो है। उन्हें ये तसल्ली रहेगी की मौका तो मिला! फिर अलग!

Elizabeth is impressed by Bhuvan's compassion. Ramsingh too cannot resist.

RAMSINGH

मेरा भी मन हो रहा है. लेकिन...

Bhuvan gives him an understanding look. All eyes are on the runners.

The drunkard goes off the field in an uncontrolled manner. The fat man is having great difficulty in running. The thin man reaches halfway panting and sits down. Two men cruise behind the group in a leisurely manner. Ishwar though tired and panting runs much ahead of Dina, but behind Arjan who leads the group.

The team cheers everyone by calling out their names. Jigni cheers Arjan who reaches first. Ishwar follows.

ISHWAR

(panting) थोडा... हपाँए जरूर गईन है... पर आदत पड जई है! दौडिहौं भुवन!

Bhuvan nods at him. The others reach him.

FAT VILLAGER

हमका तो ई ससुरी तोंद नहीं दौड़ने देती! आगे आगे दौड़ती है! लपर लपर!

BHUVAN

देखीए... आप सब ने कोसिस की! हम सबकी हिम्मत बढी! पर अर्जन और ईसर काका के अलावा और कोई जोग नहीं है!

DINA

ठीक है! तन भले साथ न दे बेटा... मन तेरे साथ है! जीतेंगे हमहई... आह... पानी!

Everyone spots Gauri carrying a pot of water and walking towards them. All rush to her and take charge of the pot. Bhuvan is surprised and happy to see her. She avoids his look and gets away from the crowd. Bhuvan eyes her as he walks towards her and circles her.

BHUVAN

ए गौरी... तू तो हाँक रई थी मैदान में कदम भी न रखूँ? ...हाय दैय्या! आ गई?

GAURI

He breaks the roll in half. Gauri anticipates that he is going to offer one half to her. But instead, he offers it to Elizabeth. Gauri is shocked.

BHUVAN

Oh! hot... पानी...

BHUVAN

तीखा है? ए गौरी देख का रही है? जल्दी... पानी दे.

Gauri glares at Bhuvan and pours out a glass of water for Elizabeth. She drinks the water and sighs in relief. Bagha, Guran, Goli and Bhura finish the pitch. Arjan tries bowling. Elizabeth watches him, keeps the glass away and rushes towards him.

ELIZABETH

No No! वैसा माफक नई अर्जन.

Elizabeth shows Arjan the bowling arm action.

Cut to ...

26A

Ismail, Lakha and four youths watch Elizabeth and the proceedings on the practise field from behind a tree.

ISMAIL

लाखा... गोली सचे कह रहा था!

LAKHA

का?

ISMAIL गोरी मेम!

LAKHA

तो ह

ISMAIL

लाखे, हमसे भूल हो गई! पर बात अब भी हत्थे हैं! हमें भुवन का साथ देना होगा!

LAKHA

का बोला? तू पगला गया है?

Ismail tries talking to the other youths also.

ISMAIL

बात समझा कर! एक अंग्रेज छोरी हमरा तन पेट बचाने खातिर गांव की मदद कर रही है! और हम गाल फुलाए बैठे हैं? लानत है! हमें भुवन का साथ देना ही होगा! अल्लाह निगेबान! चल मेरे साथ!

LAKHA

Bhuvan looks at Ismail who gropes for words. Everyone, including Elizabeth, gathers around.

ISMAIL

देख भुवन, टांग से कपडा हटे तो पूरे तन की लाज जावे है! मैंने उस दिन बुरी भली कही, सो मैं सर्मिन्दा हूँ! इस कोसिस में, मौला कसम, मैं तेरे साथ हूँ! नमाज का ईमान नहीं गवाया है!

Bhuvan is happy.

GAURI

कित्ती बढिया बात है... इस्मैलभय्या ने कित्ती हिम्मत बढा दी! है न? अब कौन है रोकनेवाला!

Bhuvan and Ismail embrace. Lakha is frustrated. He leaves with the four youths.

Suddenly, Tipu reaches Bhuvan screaming.

TIPU

Bagha drums. Everyone is joyous...

ELIZABETH

What has happened? क्या हुआ?

कल कनैय्या अस्टमी है, मेमसाब... भगवान किसन इसी दिन जन्में थे... आपको आना होगा... राधेकिसनजी के मंदिर में...

ELIZABETH

Alright!

Gauri is upset with Bhuvan for including Elizabeth and she expresses it to Jigni.

GAURI

वाके न्योता देने की का जरूरत थी?

All leave. Ramsingh stops Elizabeth.

RAMSINGH

मगर मेमसाब... कल रात तो दावत है... आपके नाम.

ELIZABETH

मैं पहले यहाँ आऊँगी!

RAMSINGH

लेकिन!..

ELIZABETH

It's alright Ramsingh.

CUT TO... (4:00)

It is Gokulashtami. Yashodamai, Bhuvan, Gauri and Elizabeth stand before the idols of Radha & Krishna. Behind them, the whole team stands in devotion.

YASHODAMAI

ओ पालन हारे, निर्गुन और न्यारे... हमरे नाथ! आपने एक अंगुली पर पर्वत उठाया! हम से तो अब जिन्दगी का बोझ भी न उठाया जावे! हे किसन मुरारी, गोबर्धन गिरधारी, तेरी सरण आए हैं... जो रस्ता हमने चुना है वाको संख से गुंजा दे परभु!

Clangs of temple bells. Crowds of villagers rush out of the temple for festivities. Elizabeth is in a trance.

ELIZABETH

भुवन... ये statue... मूरत किसकी है ?

BHUVAN

यह राधाकिसन मंदिर है मेमसाब! भगवान किसन और राधाजी की मूर्तियाँ हैं!

ELIZABETH

Fantastic! बहोत सुंदर हैं - क्या दोनों पती-पत्नी थे ?

BHUVAN

नहीं - नहीं एलायजा मेमसाब ! किसनजी की सादी रुक्मिणी से भई थी. और राधा की अनय से. लेकिन दोनों में बहुत गहरा परेम था जो एक मिसाल बनके रह गया! आप समझ लो.... कमल के पत्ते पर पानी की बूंद जैसा! एक भी नहीं भए, अलग भी नहीं! जुगों जुगों से दोनों की पूजा बरब्बर से होती चली आवे है!

Elizabeth is mesmerised by this revelation.

Gauri eyes her and Bhuvan,

Bhuvan moves forward for the Tilak and so does Gauri followed by Elizabeth.

Gauri tries to do everything immediately after Bhuvan.

Bhuvan strikes the bell.

Before Elizabeth can do the same, Gauri strikes it.

Music begins...

CUT TO... (1:00)

Scene 28: Playback Song Four Gokulashtami

Village Square Int - Ext / Night

Yashodamai performs the pooja for Lord Krishna's birth. She swings the cradle in which is Lord Krishna's idol as a child.

After the pooja, there is celebration.

It is evident that Elizabeth is slowly but surely falling in love with Bhuvan. It is also evident that Gauri is trying to make it loud and clear that it is only her. She is the Radha and the Rukmini.

Jigni discovers that Bagha likes her.

During the song, Lakha goes through a turmoil and arrives at a decision.

Mukhiya, Shambhukaka and the other elders embrace Bhuvan in acceptance.

Ramsingh arrives at the end of the song,

CUT TO... (5:00)

Scene 29: Playback Song Four Ramsingh hurries

Village Square Int - Ext / Night

Elizabeth is mesmerised by Gauri's performance

ELIZABETH

गौरी, तुम बहुत अच्छा गाती हो और नाचती भी हो!

Gauri feels proud.

RAMSINGH

मेमसाब, it is serious... आपको तुरंत निकलना चाहिये!

ELIZABETH

हां रामसिंग... भुवन मुझे जाना होगा!

YASHODAMAI

अरे बेटी.... जसन खत्म थोडी भया है... ये तो देर रात तक चलेगा! गिरधारी का जनम होने तलक.

Ramsingh hurriedly leads her away to the buggy.

CUT TO... (0:30)

Cantonment: Ballroom Int / Night

A magnificent chandelier. A party is in progress. The British in all their refinery are eagerly waiting for the ball to begin. Russell is surrounded by a few couples.

SENIOR CIVILIAN

So where is Elizabeth?

RUSSELL

She is getting ready. Excuse me!

Russell makes his way through the crowd and reaches the exit. Elizabeth's ayah is present.

RUSSELL

मेमसाब किधर है?

The ayah stutters and stammers.

AYAH

त... त.. त... तैयार हो रही है

Cut to...

30A

The buggy reaches the cantonment from the backside. Elizabeth gets off and rushes across the garden lawn through a side entrance. Ramsingh enters the ballroom, behaves as if everything is normal and approaches Russell who is in conversation with a lady.

LADY

I'm so looking forward to meeting her.

RUSSELL

Of course, Mrs. Kensington... excuse me.

Russell excuses himself.

RUSSELL

Ramsingh, What's taking her so long?

Russell walks out of the ballroom, a nervous Ramsingh trying to keep pace with him. At the entrance he receives a newly arrived guest.

Cut to ...

30B

Elizabeth rushes up the spiral staircase. An ayah waits for her, who swiftly escorts her into the room.

Cut to ...

30C

Russell finishes pleasantries with the earlier couple and leaves with Ramsingh in tow. They go up the stairs, through the corridor and reach Elizabeth's room.

He knocks. The ayah opens the door. Elizabeth stands behind her in a dazzling outfit.

RUSSELL

What took you so long? Everyone's waiting... hmmm, you look beautiful!

ELIZABETH

Thank you!

Ramsingh and the ayah sigh in relief.

Cut to...

30D

Russell and Elizabeth walk into the ballroom.

RUSSELL

Ladies and gentlemen... Miss Elizabeth Russell!

They start a dance as they cross the floor, announcing the beginning of the ball. Other couples join in. Smith watches Elizabeth, mesmerised.

Cut to ...

30E

Lakha is outside the palace, indecisive, avoids the look of the Indian sentry and moves towards British Guard.

Cut to ...

30F

Elizabeth and Russell are surrounded by other officers, suitable bachelors.

RUSSELL

Elizabeth, this is Capt. Edward Edinburgh... and, this is Capt. Richard Cummins...

A sentry whispers something to Smith who walks up to Russell.

SMITH

Sir, a villager is here to see you.

RUSSELL

Not now!... tomorrow in the office.

SMITH

Excuse me sir, he says he has important information about the match.

RUSSELL

Hmm... excuse me!

Russell leaves the ballroom with Smith.

CUT TO... (1:30)

Scene 31 Lakha betrays

Cantonment: Russell's Office Int / Night

Lakha is led into Russell's office by Smith. He removes the blanket from his face after he looks around and feels safe and bows before Russell.

LAKHA

हुजूर माईबाप की जय!

RUSSELL

क्या खबर देना चाहते हो?

LAKHA

सरकार... वो भुवन अपना दल बनाए रहा है लेकिन...

RUSSELL

लेकिन क्या?

LAKHA

जान बक्सें सरकार, छावनी से कोई गोरी मेम वाकी खिल सीखने में मदद कर रही है.

RUSSEL

गोरी मेम?

LAKHA

हाँ सरकार... मैंने आज अपनी आखिन से निहारा है.

RUSSELL

हमम... क्या पहना था... इस गोरी मेम ने ?

LAKHA

आप जैसी सफेद फतूई और बडा सा झब्बेदार घागरा!

Russell's minds races. He leads Lakha to the door and moves the curtain aside. The ballroom can be seen.

RUSSELL

क्या वो गोरी मेम इनमें से है?

Lakha eyes everyone and spots Elizabeth dancing.

LAKHA

वो रही सरकार!

Russell is shocked.

RUSSELL

'कोई गलती तो नहीं कर रहा है?

LAKHA

गलती की तो सूली पे चढा दे सरकार....

Russell walks back to the table.

RUSSELL

Alright!... तो तुम भी हो दल में.

LAKHA

नाही सरकार... हम भुवन की तरह सनकियें थोडी ही हैं जो सरकारी पहाड से दुस्मनी मोल लूँ... अपनी जान प्यारी है!

RUSSELL

Hmm... तुम हमको ये सब क्यों बता रहा है ?

LAKHA

कटती हुई मुर्गी का दरद मुर्गी ही जाने है अन्नदाता... मैं भी अंदर कट रहा हूँ... बात ही कुछ ऐसी है... भुवन की हार में हमरी जीत है!

Russell is thoughtful.

RUSSELL

Hmm... लखा तुम एक काम करो... तुम भुवन के दल मे शामिल हो जाओ.

LAKHA

ई का कह रहे है सरकार? हम समझा नाही...

RUSSELL

तुम भुवन के दल में रहोंगे... लेकिन काम हमारा करोंगे.

LAKHA

समझ गए सरकार... समझ गए.

Lakha covers himself with the blanket and leaves. Smith stops him and shows him another exit.

CUT TO ... (1:30)

Cantonment: Ballroom

Ext / Night

Russell leaves of his office and enters the ballroom. He reaches Elizabeth who is having a pleasant conversation with a couple of officers.

RUSSELL

Excuse her... excuse us!

She politely excuses herself.

Cut to ...

32A

Russell leads her to a secluded section away from the ballroom. She gets a little nervous.

ELIZABETH

Yes Andrew... what is it?

RUSSELL

So Eliza dear, you've been sight-seeing. How is the countryside?

Elizabeth tries to be casual.

ELIZABETH

It's beautiful. The mountains... the woods... the cattle...

RUSSELL

And the villagers?

ELIZABETH

I didn't see any...

Russell cannot control his anger any more.

RUSSELL

My foot you didn't see any. You were with the villagers and whats-his-name... teaching them cricket. You thought I wouldn't come to know? You have the audacity to go against your brother? Now you listen to me carefully. You are not to leave the cantonment without my permission. Is that understood?

Elizabeth is quiet, doesn't say anything and rushes inside.

RUSSELL

Bloody farmers!

CUT TO... (1:00)

INTERMISSION

Bhuvan and his team are seated in Ismail's courtyard. Salma is doing some household work. Kazi smokes a 'hooka' on his khatiya Lakha watches them from a distance. He gathers courage and walks up to them.

LAKHA

पता नहीं! कैसे कहें. बडा पछतावा होय रहा है. का हम तुमरे साथ खेल सकत हैं?

Lakha looks at Gauri who glares at him. Bhuvan winks at the gang.

BHUVAN

बिल्कुल नहीं... तू नहीं खेल सकत!

LAKHA

काहे?

BHUVAN

खेल देखकर समझ. यह लकडी काटना नहीं है. कुछ गुन गरमा होनी चाहिए... क्यों?

He asks everyone.

ISMAIL

गोली को देख... गोफन की तरह गेंद फर्राटे से फेंकता हैं.

GOLI

और ये भूरा, मुर्गियों की तरह गप्प से गेंद गुपच लेता है.

BHURA

अर्जन नाल ठोंकते ठोंकते निसाना साध चुका है.

ISHWAR

हाँ सही है.

ARJAN

ईसर काका के हाथ से गेंद तो का, धन भी नहीं फिसल सके है.

All laugh. Arjan continues.

ARJAN

और ये वैद भी है, इनकी जरूरत पडेगी चोट चपेट में.

ISHWAR

बाघा की ताकत कौन न जाने है!

Bagha looks at Guran and expresses in gestures.

ISHWAR

गुरन में जूझने का जुनून है, जो रोग की तरह फैलता है.

GURAN

अच्छा है!

BHUVAN

और इस्माईल जहाँ तक मोको याद है... हमरी गिल्ली-डंडे में हमेसा टक्कर रही है.

TIPU

और मैं ?

BHUVAN

अरे हाँ... टीपू - जो बहुत होसियार है. सो लाखा तोहरा का गुन है?

LAKHA

मैं?.. मैं तेजी से दौड सकता हूँ!

BHUVAN

अच्छा, ठीक है. तो एक काम कर! मंदिर की सीढियाँ तीन बार तेजी से चढ़नी और उतरनी पडेंगी... तेजी से. हो सके हैं?

Lakha gulps as he looks at the temple. Bhuvan steals a look at Gauri who controls her smile. Lakha starts off as everyone watches. Gauri walks up to Bhuvan.

GAURI

Scene 34 Elizabeth sneaks out

Church / Storeroom / Cantonment Estate
Ext / Day

In the cantonment, a makeshift church. It consists of about 4 benches - Elizabeth is kneeling inside praying. She is alone.

Cut to ...

34A

Storeroom

A drawer is opened and a small box is removed. It is Ramsingh. He looks around to see if anyone has seen him and leaves.

Cut to ...

34B

Cantonment Estate

Elizabeth walks towards a side exit of the cantonment palace which is secluded. The stable boy, Mahto, waits with a horse, conspicuously. Ramsingh also reaches and helps her up on the side saddle. He gives her the box.

RAMSINGH

ये लीजिए मेमसाब... सँभालकर... Take care Memsahib!

Elizabeth rides off. Ramsingh looks at Mahto.

RAMSINGH

तूने कुछ नहीं देखा महतो!

Mahto nods furiously.

CUT TO... (1:00)

Elizabeth emerges from the woods on horseback. Bhuvan is happy to see her. Lakha, who was holding the ball, drops it, shocked to see her.

BHUVAN

नमस्ते मेमसाब. आपके साथ ने सब में जोस फूँक दिया है. सब आपकी किरपा से है.

Everyone cheers Elizabeth. She smiles. She gives the box to Bhuvan.

ELIZABETH

Bhuvan takes the ball. The team crowds to get a glimpse of the real thing.

BHUVAN

वाह! इस गेंद से सुरू गोली करेगा.

Gauri alongwith Jigni arrives with food for Bhuvan. Durga, Salma & Kesariya also accompany her.

GAURI

अभी कुछ नाही... पैले पेट पूजा करो.

BHUVAN

पेट के लिए ही गेंद पूजा कर रहे हैं, गौरी! थोडी देर ठहर जा!.. पहले खेलें.

The players spread out. Goli moves for the run up. Bhuvan holds the bat and waits for Goli to bowl. But he stands in a gilli-danda stance, with the bat between his legs, ready to hit the ball on either sides of the pitch. Elizabeth shows Bhuvan the two-handed grip and the proper stance. Her hands touch Bhuvan's. Gauri notices that telescopically. Guran observes Gauri as wellas Bhuvan.

GURAN

अडचन!

Gauri freezes as she realises what Guran had meant. Bhuvan is uncomfortable and so goes back to his original stance.

BHUVAN

मेमसाब, माफ करना, लेकिन यही ठीक है.

Elizabeth smiles and shrugs her shoulders. Goli delivers the ball. Bhuvan connects. The ball goes past Guran in a straight drive and crosses the boundary line.

It rests next to a pair of feet. A hand picks up the ball. It is a tall and well built Sikh. Guran stares at him.

GURAN

ए, गेंद दे !

The Sikh stares at Guran.

SIKH

देता हूँ.

Guran spreads his hands to receive the ball. The Sikh looks at the wicket, starts walking slowly and then breaks into a run leaving Guran gaping. Bhuvan realises that the Sikh is going to bowl and takes up the stance. The others watch, perplexed. The Sikh reaches the crease and delivers the ball in a near correct bowling action. The stumps are uprooted leaving Bhuvan aghast. The Sikh regains his posture, breathing heavily and looks at everyone.

SIKH

भुवन कौन है ?

Bhuvan takes a couple of steps towards him.

BHUVAN

मैं हूँ भुवन - तुमरा नाम?

SIKH

में देवा... देवासिंग सोढ्ढी. बुरहापूर से आया हूँ. सुना है अँग्रजों दे खिलाफ लडन वास्ते कमर कस्सी है?

BHUVAN

हाँ, मगर लाठी-भाले से नहीं, गेंद-बल्ले से!

DEVA

लाठी-भाले से हो या गेंद-बल्ले से. में हमेशा अँग्रजों के खिलाफ हर जंग विच शामिल होना चाहूँगा. मुझे इस लडाई विच हाथ बटाने दो भुवन... ये खेल में पहले खेल चुका हूँ.

BHUVAN

कब खेला?

DEVA

मैं अंग्रेजों दे लश्कर विच था. एक दिन बरदाश्त नहीं होया और पिस्सू दे पुतरों को सलाम फेंककर लोट आया. मुझे अंग्रेजों से नफरत है.

Bhuvan realises that Deva is referring to Elizabeth.

BHUVAN

धीरज धरो... मेमसाब हमरे साथ है... खिलाफ नहीं.

Deva looks suspiciously at Elizabeth.

ELIZABETH

तुम खेल के बारे में क्या जानते हो ?

DEVA

दो बातें मेमसाब - गेंद फेंकू तो तीनों लकडियों दी धि अयाँ उडा दूँ और गेंद खेलूँ तो गेंद चीर के रख दूँ.

Elizabeth is stunned on hearing this simple deduction of the game.

ELIZABETH

That's good!

BHUVAN

देवा, गेंदबाजी तो देख ली तुमरी - अब बल्ला उठाओ, गोली, गेंद फेंक.

GAURI

गोली गेंद अलग रख... पहले खाना खा लो.

The women spread out with their respective men. Ishwar takes Deva. Tipu tags along with him. Gauri is about to open the packet when Elizabeth tells Bhuvan.

ELIZABETH

मुझे देर हो रही है, मुझे जाना होगा... भुवन, तुमसे कुछ कहना है.

BHUVAN

जी मेमसाब !

Elizabeth smiles at Gauri.

ELIZABETH

Bye, Gauri.

GAURI

जी, नमस्ते !

Elizabeth walks away followed by Bhuvan. Guran, seated under a tree growls.

GURAN

अडचन!!

Gauri looks at him and then back at the two, a little distance away.

Cut to...

35A

Elizabeth gropes for words as she expresses her feelings.

ELIZABETH

भुवन, मेरा कॅटोन्मेंट से निकलना मुश्किल है. अब मैं तुमसे रोज नहीं मिल सकती. और वैसे भी अब तुम्हें लोगों का साथ है, लेकिन वो मेरी वजह से नहीं तुम्हारी खुद की वजह से है. क्योंकि तुम एक अच्छे आदमी हो और अच्छे दोस्त भी... तुम्हें पता है, बचपन से मेरा कोई दोस्त नहीं था... जब तक तुम मिले... Elizabeth talks to herself in English saying "Don't say it Elizabeth. Don't say it." She takes a deep breath and faces him.

Bhuvan does not understand but smiles as she walks away.

ELIZABETH

I'm falling in love with you!

She gets on the horse. Bhuvan joins his hands.

BHUVAN

जी... नमस्ते !

She disappears into the woods.

Cut to ...

Puzzled, Bhuvan returns to where Gauri was. She is nowhere to be seen. He sees the open, untouched packet on the ground. Jigni stands next to it fuming, waiting.

BHUVAN

JIGNI

BHUVAN

कहाँ?

Jigni glares at him. Bhuvan notices that.

BHUVAN

एैसे काहे घूर रही है मुझे?

JIGNI

हफ...!

Jigni leaves in a huff. Bhuvan mutters to himself.

BHUVAN

कहाँ गई होगी?!

CUT TO... (5:00)

Gauri is seated ontop of the hillock. She is crying. She seems to be talking to the heavens.

GAURI

काहे वो मेरी बात नहीं समझता? तू ही बता कैसे समझाऊँ उसे? मैं उसे खोना नहीं चाहती.

Bhuvan reaches the base of the hillock.

BHUVAN

गौरी... गौरी...

She does not respond to him. She hurriedly wipes her tears. Bhuvan walks up to her.

BHUVAN

कमाल करती है तू, सारा गाँव ढूँढ लिया - और तू यहाँ बैठी है. रोटी छोडकर काहे आई ?

GAURI

मेरी मर्जी!

BHUVAN

का मतबल तेरी मर्जी... कम से कम मोसे कहके तो आती...

GAURI

कैसे कहती... उस करम फूँकी गोरी मेम से तोको फुर्सत मिले तब ना... वाईके आते ही कबूतर की तरह पंख फडफडाते हो! दूसरा कुछ दिखाई नही देता... और आज तो मोसे ऐसे भूल गए, जैसे मैं वहाँ थी ही नही!

Bhuvan realises that she is upset about something.

BHUVAN

बात समझ ले गौरी, मेमसाब को मेरे से कुछ जरूरी बात करनी थी.

GAURI

जरूरी बात करनी थी, तो वही पे नहीं कर सकते थे... अलग अकेले में ले जाने की का जरूरत थी? मैं का सब समझती नहीं कि गंगा किधर को बह रही है...

Bhuvan decides to tease her.

BHUVAN

ऽऽ हाय दरद मोरे होए बिछी के मारे ऽऽ... तोको जलन हो रही है.

GAURI

जलन... मैं काहे जलने लगी भला...

BHUVAN

तोको जलन हो रही है... और मैं जानू हूँ किससे...

GAURI

अब के बाद मोसे बात करने की कोसिस मत कर.

BHUVAN

तो... आज के बाद तू भी मोसे बात नहीं करेगी.

GAURI

ठीक सुना.

BHUVAN

तो... आज के बाद तू मेरे लिए परेंठा भी नही लाएगी.

GAURI

बिल्कुल नहीं... और मेरे घर पर आने की हिम्मत नहीं करना...

She gets up and starts going down the hillock. Bhuvan gets up smiling.

BHUVAN

गौरी... सारे गाँव में एक ही तो घर है जिसके आँगन में नीम का पेड है.

Gauri keeps walking.

BHUVAN

दो भैंसे और तीन बकरियाँ भी है...

As she walks further away, Bhuvan's voice gets louder.

BHUVAN

और मैं जानू हूँ पगलिया कि वो घर मोरा है...

Gauri stops and turns slowly to look at him, her expressions changing.

BHUVAN

और तू माई को भी पसंद है...

Overjoyed by this confession, Gauri is happy, feels shy and runs away. Bhuvan runs after her and holds her hand.

CUT TO... (2:15)

Scene 37: Playback Song Five

प्यार & Love

Countryside / Village / Cantonment Ext / Day - Evening - Night

The song is in two languages - Hindi and English.

Bhuvan and Gauri confess their love for each other while Elizabeth fantasises about her love for Bhuvan.

In the song, there will be no reality with respect to costumes and locations.

- A. Bhuvan and Gauri ploughing the field together.
- B. Elizabeth imagining Bhuvan dressed like a Lord and she like a village girl.
- C. Russell returns to the cantonment and Lakha informs Smith who informs Russell.
- D. Elizabeth puts a bindi on her forehead.

CUT TO... (6:00)

Elizabeth retaliates

Cantonment: Elizabeth's Room

Int / Night

As the song ends, Elizabeth is seated before the mirror, admiring the bindi on her forehead when a pair of hands grasp her from behind and turn her around violently. It is Russell.

RUSSELL

Despite my warnings, you continue to meet those bloody farmers... damn you!

He pushes her on to the bed. She reacts sharply to this violence.

ELIZABETH

How dare you raise your hand?

RUSSELL

The same way you raised your hand on my pride... and I'm not going to tolerate your nonsense anymore. You can damn well do what you want in London, but not here. You will pack your bags and leave for England by the next ship. Is that clear?

ELIZABETH

Let's make some things clear to you, Andrew... Stop telling me what to do. I'm not a child. And get this straight. I'm not leaving Champaner. And I'll go to the village as and when I so wish.

Russell is taken aback. He controls himself.

RUSSELL

Tell me Eliza, what's so special about them that makes you go against your own brother?

ELIZABETH

Nothing special about them, Andrew. You're the one who's unfair with your silly challenge! That's why I decided to help them. And mark my words, they'll give you a tough fight!

CUT TO ... (1:00)

The ground is full of people in a festive mood – like a Mela. Everyone is eager to watch Bhuvan and his team practise the game. The team of 10 stands in a group, engrossed in a discussion. Elizabeth tries to follow what is being said.

MUKHIYA

भई का हो रहा है? गाँव तुम लोगन का खेल देखना चाहते है.

BHUVAN

हमें ग्यारवाँ खिलाडी नाही मिल रहा है.

MUKHIYA

लो... अभी जुटाते है हम! भीमा को ले लें?

ISHWAR

अरे नाम का भीमा है. जरा जरा देर में पीठ का दर्द!

MUKHIYA

तो फिर... कासी राम.

BHURA

नाही मुखियाजी... दौडत पे ही टेढा तिरछा हो गया तो कासी अलग... राम अलग!

BHUVAN

हमें तगडा आदमी चाहिए. आप रहने दीजिए... देखा जई है, चलो देवा. गेंद फेंको. ईसरकाका आप बल्ला साधो.

The team spreads out. Villagers start applauding. Ishwar raises the bat to acknowledge. The cheers increase. Elizabeth takes the position of the Umpire and signals Deva to bowl. Deva takes his runup and delivers the ball. Ishwar swings the bat connecting it with the ball to his own amazement.

The crowd cheers as the ball travels up in the air and Bagha tries to catch it, but misses. Jigni is disappointed, Bagha picks up the ball, in frustration, and throws it to Goli. The crowd cheers once again, not quite knowing what is going on.

Deva bowls again and Bhuvan mis-fields. The ball goes beyond him and lands near a man crouched on the ground. Bhuvan gestures him to pick up the ball and throw it. The man is hesitant.

BHUVAN

कचरा... गेंद फैंक!

Kachra gets up, moves towards the ball, still hesitant.

BHUVAN

अबे टिपुरता ही रहेगा? गेंद फैंक ना!

Kachra picks it up and throws it with his deformed hand. The ball takes a bounce before Bhuvan but spins away. Bhuvan manages to catch it, but gives a surprised look at Kachra.

BHUVAN

का किया तूने ?

KACHRA

मैंने ? मैंने का किया... तुम्हई कहेऊ फेंक... सो...

Kachra looks worried.

BHUVAN

इदर आ!

KACHRA

मैंने कौन जुरुम कीहीन... तुम्हई कहेयो सो मैंने...

The rest of the team wonders what Bhuvan is up to.

BHUVAN

कचरा... गेंद फिर से फैंक. सब लोग... एलाइजा मेमसाब देखो... कचरा को और वाकी गेंद को...

Elizabeth watches Kachra intently.

KACHRA

मैंने ऐसा का कर दिए?

BHUVAN

कचरा... गेंद्र फैंक! नाही बाए से नाही... दाहिने से...

Kachra shifts the ball from the left to the right hand and throws the ball. It spins again. Bhuvan misses it and Goli catches it.

BHUVAN

वाह का फिरकी मारत है... देखा... मेमसाब?

ELIZABETH

Amazing. He is actually spinning the ball! गेंद कितनी अच्छी तरह से spin करता है.

BHUVAN

मिल गवा हमें ग्यारवाँ खिलाडी. ईसरकाका, आप जाइए सामना कीजिए, देवा - कचरा को दिखा गेंद कहाँ से फैंकनी है, लाखा - तू डंडियों के पीछे हल ले... गोली, ला गेंद दे...

Goli and Bhura do not respond as they are a little indefinite and observe everyone. Everyone else stares at Bhuvan who realises that nobody has moved from their place. Lakha looks at Bhuvan defiantly.

BHUVAN

का हुआ ? खडे खडे मुँह काहे निहार रहे हो सारे?

LAKHA

भुवन. हम तो नाही खेलेंगे.

BHUVAN

काहे? का हो गया इकदम?

LAKHA

ये कचरा अछूत है... वो हमरे साथ नहीं खेल सकता.

Bhuvan is flabbergasted.

ISHWAR

पक्की बात है. हमऊ एक अछूत के साथ कंधा नाही साँट सकें.

Goli, Bhura and Arjan also voice their support.

GOLI

ये नाही हो सकत है भुवन... तनिके सोचौ!

BHURA

हम भी नाही खेलेंगे.

ARJAN

और हमऊ

Elizabeth cannot understand what is going on. The Mukhiya and a few others walk on to the field.

MUKHIYA

यह का अनर्थ कर रहे हो भुवन? तलवार की धार से गन्ना काट के खेत कलांकित कर रहे हो? गोरों के साथ लड़ना धरम है... पर एक अछूत को साथ लैके पूरा दूध भ्रस्ट नाही होने देंगें भुवन!

ISMAIL

कचरा... चल भाग यहाँ से.

Kachra takes a step away. Bhuvan holds him by the shoulder. Women gasp on seeing him touch. Mai and Gauri are also shocked.

BHUVAN

कचरा... तू कहूँ नाही जाएगा.

He turns to face Mukhiya.

BHUVAN

दूध पर छूत-अछूत का छाप लगाएके दूध आप भस्ट कर रहे हो! सारे गाँव की सांस इस छूत-अछूत के धुएँ से काहे घोंट रहे हो, मुखियाजी? चमडी के नाम पर मन को छलना नेक है का? काहे पूजते हो राम को जिनने सबरी के जूठे बेर खाए? जो भगवान सबकी नैय्या पार लगावे है उनकी नैय्या को एक छोटे जाती के नाविक ने पार लगाई. ये सब जानके भी छूत-अछूत की बात कर रहे हों? और आप ईसरकाका... पीडा हरते हो? रोगी की नाडी परखके इलाज करते हो? का आपका सास्त्र यही कहता है कि किसी अछूत का इलाज ना किया जाए? उसे मरने दिया जाए? ये तो इन्सानियत के नाम पर सबसे पडा कलंक होगा... और फिर कोई भी वैद को भगवान का दूसरा रूप नहीं मानेगा.

Bhuvan holds Kachra who has tears in his eyes. There is silence. No one looks at Bhuvan. Deva breaks the silence.

DEVA

आज तक मैं हमेशा गुलामी के खिलाफ लडता आया, लेकिन आज मैं तेरा गुलाम हो गया!

ISHWAR

भुवन बेटे, जो आँखे अब पूरी तरह खुल गई, उनमें सरम भी तो नहीं आ सके. तू ठीकै कहता है.

ISMAIL

मैं ईसरभाई के साथ सहमत हूँ

MUKHIYA

कचरा हमरे साथ खेलेगा!

The whole village cheers. Yashodamai and Gauri are emotionally moved as mother and girlfriend.

Suddenly they hear the sounds of neighing horses. They turn to see a party of about a dozen horses headed by Russell and Smith beyond the boundary line.

Bhuvan and Russell's eyes meet.

He notices Elizabeth who looks at him defiantly.

One by one, the players start joining Bhuvan, their eyes on Russell in defiance. Russell seems to be counting and realises that they are eleven.

The team is complete.

Russell is unnerved.

CUT TO... (5:00)

Scene 40: Playback Song Six Preparation

Countryside / Village / Cantonment Ext / Day

Silence except for a few birds chirping. Cows and buffaloes are grazing on a small hillock. Suddenly one buffalo stops grazing and lifts his head. A distant thudding sound is heard. It looks around but doesn't see anything. Another buffalo also reacts, and a third. They all look in one direction. The downward slope of the hillock. The thudding sounds approach closer and closer. The cattle look on.

And from the slope emerges the group of eleven, all running as fast as they can. As they come closer the cattle panic and make way for them. Ismail leads the whole team on a countryside run. The weakest are Ishwar and Lakha. The strongest being Bhuvan, Deva and Arjan.

The song consists of preparation montage:

The team going through stretching exercises with great difficulty. Deva teaches everyone all that he has learned in the British army with respect to stretching and body exercises. The weakest of the lot are Bagha and Ishwar, with whom he develops a bond. Tipu constantly stays on with Deva.

The womenfolk making rural home-made pads called godhadees for the team.

The team trying to run with the godhadees.

Bhuvan trains the team to run between the wickets while wearing the 'godhadees'. The naturals are Ismail and Bagha. The weakest is Ishwar. Guran manages but funnily.

Woodcutters cutting wood and scraping them into bats and stumps.

Lakha and a few others, including Harikaka cutting wood. Bhuvan, Arjan and Ismail scraping them into bats and stumps.

Catching hen / Catch practice, diving, getting hurt.

Bhura shows tactics of catching hens, then applies it for catch practice. Arjan is stiff. Ismail and Ishwar are good. Guran is petrified of hens. Bagha is hopeless as he keeps dropping the ball.

Gauri's nursing home.

In catch practice, everyone gets hurt. The injured are taken care of by Ishwar and Gauri. A proximity develops between Bhuvan and her. Jigni goes red in the face as she nurses Bagha who gives her a bunch of 'champa' flowers.

Batting and Bowling.

0

Arjan explains the most effective part of the bat. He gives batting classes to Kachra and Bhura, who are the weakest and to Ismail, Lakha and Guran who are the best. Bagha has a special ability - he can play lefty as well as righty. Deva teaches bowling. The naturals are Goli and Kachra. The trainees are Bhuvan, Ismail, Lakha, Guran and Tipu. Ishwar makes everyone spread round him in the distance, as he stands behind the wickets. Then he makes each one of the team aim at the stumps while he smartly keeps the wickets.

The villagers ploughing and digging a pit to create a pitch. Community lunch.

Bhuvan and gang sitting atop a tree at the polo cricket ground. They watch Yardley bowl and uproot stumps. Bhuvan and gang apply what they just learned at the polo cricket ground.

CUT TO... (4:00)

At the polo ground, the British team is having a game. Russel is fielding in the covers. Yardley, a large man with whiskers covering half his face, bowls. The batsman, Burton, hits a boundary.

BURTON

How was that?

Yardley glares at Burton and goes for his run up. Infuriated, he delivers a short-pitched ball, which takes Burton by surprise and hits him on the shoulder causing him to fall on the stumps.

YARDLEY

How was that?

Burton is declared out by the umpire. The match is over. All the players rush to Burton, pick him up and move to the pavilion. Russel walks up to Yardley.

RUSSEL

That was not a good ball Yardley! There's a difference between pace and ferocity.

YARDLEY

I cannot take it when someone shows me the boundary.

RUSSEL

Take it easy! We're just playing, to enjoy ourselves. Save your energy for the match with the darkies.

YARDLEY

I won't even have to run-up for them. I'll just stand at the crease and throw the ball.

The players laugh.

RUSSEL

I'm going to announce the batting order now.

Russel's team consists of Burton, Flynn, Welles, Smith, North, Wesson, Yardley, Benson, Harrisson. Brooks and Willis. Tea and refreshments are served.

In the distance, a crowd of about five hundred passes through the field.

SMITH

Where are the villagers going?

RAMSINGH

They have come from the neighbouring villages – to watch the home team practice.

Russel is alarmed.

SMITH

Not practice, but lose.

Everyone laughs. Smith gets an idea.

SMITH

Oh... even I'd like to see them practise. Maybe I could learn something...

WILLIS

Could be fun. Let's go Brooks. Anyone else would like to join us?

CUT TO... (2:00)

The two Mukhiyas - Ramprasad and Namdeo arrive with their villagers.

The crowds cheer and applaud the team as they practice. Goli is bowling and Arjan is batting. After a couple of balls, Arjan breaks his stance.

Six British players in white uniforms approach them casually. Smith leads them.

Willis takes the ball from Goli and after a long run up bowls to Arjan. He misses the ball completely and the stumps are uprooted.

Smith and the other British players applaud Willis.

SMITH

Good ball, Willis.

Brooks moves up to Arjan and takes his bat. Before going in a stance he reacts at the strangeness of the bat. He asks Goli to bowl who looks at Bhuvan for approval. Bhuvan nods.

The crowd is silent. Goli bowls.

Brooks connects and the ball lands beyond the boundary line.

SMITH

Good shot, Brooks!

Wesson scrutinises the home-made pads i.e. godhadees.

WESSON

Look at these works of art.

The Englishmen laugh. Bhuvan's team doesn't know how to react to this humiliation. The two Mukhiyas and their villagers look at the goings-on in disbelief.

Smith walks up to Bhuvan and looks him in the eye.

SMITH

जल्द ही मिलेंगे!

Bhuvan does not bat an eyelid.

BHUVAN

जरूर!

The Englishmen leave whistling and back-slapping. The visiting villagers get up, disillusioned.

SHAMBHUKAKA

अगर बरसात होती तो हमऊ तिगुना लगान भी दै देते.

RAMPRASAD

अब हमें कोई नाही बचा सके.

NAMDEO

उन्हें हराने का तो अब हम सुपना भी नाही देख सके.

The villagers start to leave the field. The players don't move, stunned. Bhuvan is shaken up.

CUT TO... (2:30)

arrin Knan broductions by the second second

Village Temple Int / Night

Bhuvan enters the temple and stands before the idol. He keeps staring at it silently. A bell is heard. It is Yashodamai. She stands next to him and bows before the idol.

YASHODAMAI

का सोच रहा है, भुवन?

BHUVAN

माँ, ई बीडा उठाकर मैंने कोई गलती तो नाही की?

YASHODAMAI

RUSSELL

I've been thinking about cricket.

SMITH

What about it?

RUSSELL

An unpredicatable game... Patrick, do you think there is any outside chance of our losing this bet?

SMITH

Not a hope in hell, sir. But why these sudden doubts?

Cut to ...

47A

Elizabeth is out on the cantonment terrace, thoughtful. The palace dome gleams in the moonlight behind her. She sees a man completely covered run surreptitiously across the lawn towards Russell's office. She wonders.

Cut to ...

47B

The man enters. Russell asks the servant who is swinging the roof fan to leave. The man removes the blanket from his head. It is Lakha.

LAKHA

CUT TO... (00:30)

Russel stands before Col. Boyer. Major Cotton and Major Warren are seated.

BOYER

Do you know why are you here?

RUSSEL

No Sir.

BOYER

Interesting. Well, it's the same matter again! So...you have arrested the farmers' team. On what charge?

RUSSEL

They stole cricket equipment from the cantonment.

BOYER

Interesting!

Boyer picks up an envelope and brings out a letter.

BOYER

How is this Miss Elizabeth Russel related to you?

Russel's mind starts to race on hearing this.

RUSSEL

...she is my sister.

BOYER

Well, she writes to us that it was she, who gave the equipment to the farmers. So there seems to be no question of stealing...

WARREN

... hence no charge, hence no arrest.

COTTON

Even then, if you are keen on making an arrest, she would be the person you are looking for.

RUSSEL

Sir, in fact...

WARREN

The fact, sir, is that you are a coward.

RUSSEL

Not at all, Sir.

BOYER

In that case, you should release the farmers immediately... don't you think?

RUSSEL

Yes Sir!

BOYER

I want them released by 1100 hrs.! You may leave!

RUSSEL

Yes Sir!

Russel starts to leave and reaches the door.

COTTON

Oh Captain,.. one more thing. Please let us know the day of the match. We'd like to get good umpires from Cawnpore. Can't have anyone playing dirty, can we? After all, we're Englishmen and a very fair people!

Russel clicks his heels in anger and leaves.

Cotton looks at Boyer and Warren victoriously.

Boyer and Warren exchange a look.

CUT TO... (2:00)

Scene 52

Russell slaps Elizabeth

Cantonment: Elizabeth's Room Ext-Int / Day

Violent horses enter the cantonment, led by Russell.

He dismounts and walks angrily into the main wing.

Cut to

52A

He walks through the corridor, goes up the flight of stairs and enters Elizabeth's room.

Cut to ...

52B

Elizabeth gets up in defiance.

Russell walks up to her and slaps her.

She falls on the bed.

RUSSELL

You have exceeded my limits of tolerance. You have caused me humiliation before my superiors by sending them that damn letter. If only I could kill you... but I happen to remember that you are my blood. I will now leave nothing unturned to make sure that your team suffers the worst humiliation imaginable. I shall have the tax threefold. I'm postponing your return to England because I want you to see for yourself how those villagers starve to death one by one, inch by inch, right in front of your eyes. And to hasten your agony, I have yet another glorious plan.

Russell leaves the room.

Elizabeth gets up trembling with rage.

CUT TO... (1:00)

Cantonment: Jail Ext / Day

The jail door is opened.

The team comes out, bewildered.

Bhuvan is met by Russell and Smith.

RUSSELL

- B Ramsingh comes with equipment. Bhuvan rejects it saying he does not need it.
- C Elizabeth wants to come to the village. Ramsingh stops her and tells her that she should leave Bhuvan alone for some time.
- P Bagha drops a catch.
- P Ishwar collects the ball and lifts off the bails.
- V The farmers tell a man who is leaving Champaner-10 days.
- P Arjan connects a ball correctly.
- C Elizabeth pacing in her room thinking.
- NV A man in a neighbouring village declares that 5 days remain for the match.

If we win the toss, we'll bat and drum up a huge total.

ALL

Cheers! Cheers!

PURAN SINGH

Three large tents, two for the British and one for the Royals have been erected at the pavilion end.

Slowly, sounds are heard in the woods, the hills and every route leading to the ground. Thousands of villagers start accumulating in every possible corner of the field. Some perch on the nearby trees.

Buggies and horsemen start arriving. Officers in uniform, their wives dressed formally; start taking their seats in the pavilion. Boyer, Cotton and Warren arrive with some top brass. Elizabeth sits next to the them. Russell and his team occupy one whole tent.

Bhuvan and his team are on the other side with Gauri, Yashodamai, Shambhukaka, Mukhiya and the rest of Champaner villagers.

Bhuvan looks at her sharply.

BHUVAN

The two teams enter the field to a thunderous applause. On one side is the white-n-white uniformed team. On the other side, a dhoti-bandi clad barefoot team.

Boyer, Cotton, and Warren are amused to see this. Warren feels that this is a historic moment for cricket. Boyer walks onto the ground, the two umpires on either side. He walks through the two lines of players to the two Captains. The umpire tosses a coin. Russell wins the toss. He opts to bat. Boyer wishes both the Captains and leaves the field.

The players walk off the field. Elizabeth is very uncomfortable in the British tent as she would rather be with the villagers. Gauri and her eyes meet for a brief moment and Gauri looks away.

Bhuvan's team comes together in a group. Bhuvan instructs the team field placing and all take their respective positions with Ishwar behind the wickets. There is a loud applause as Deva starts his run up and bowls to Burton. The ball pitches at a good length and Burton strikes the ball. There is chaos as all the fielders leave their positions and run after the ball. Bhuvan asks them to calm down.

The second ball is played well. It heads towards Ismail who leaps and collects it. No run. The third ball is cut in the slip. It is not a catch but Bhura grabs it quickly. The crowd applauds the fielding. The fourth ball is played towards Lakha who misses it deliberately and a boundary is scored. Bagha walks up to Lakha, tears in his eyes, making guttural sounds trying to goad him not to make a mistake. I can not play unless he bowls properly.

The game is stopped.

There is commotion as the umpires consult each other and call Goli.

UMPIRE 1

You see we have a problem here. You will have to bowl conventionally.

Goli looks at Bhuvan questioningly.

Bhuvan is in a dilemma as to how the situation has to be tackled.

Elizabeth enters the field and appeals on behalf of the villagers.

ELIZABETH

Excuse me. Sir.

Russell sees this and he too enters the field.

ELIZABETH

I think you are being unfair to the home team.

Elizabeth arrives there. Mukhiya meets her half way and folds his hands.

Kachra has taken 1 wicket, Ismail has taken a catch at forward short leg.

Bhuvan I wicket, leg before wicket.

Deva 1 wicket, Ishwar has taken catches behind and a brilliant run out by Lakha.

Boyer, Cotton and Warren feel that the villagers team is under immense pressure.

Rajah discusses with his noblemen in the fort.

The villagers are completely nervous that they have got only 90 for 5.

Bhuvan and his team analyse their mistakes. The ferocity of the bowlers was too intimidating. Bhuvan re-checks the game plan and the placement of fielders and the gaps.

The villagers come in to but with Guran and Bhuvan. They resume at 90 for 5.
Russell makes a strategic move of changing from pace to spin which leaves Guran flummoxed.
Guran falls to the spin, and one by one all players fall while Bhuvan holds fort. By lunch, the home team is all out for a score of 160 runs in the first innings.

Post lunch. The score is 90 for no loss.
